Do You Paint Your Clothes Too?

When I lived up north, I always had two wardrobes of clothes: Summer and Winter. When I moved to Florida, I thought I would be able to go down to one wardrobe since I wouldn't need the winter clothes any longer. I was wrong! Now I find I have two set of clothes again: Clothes fit to wear in public and Clothes with paint on them!

I will go into the studio to "just do something small" so I don't bother changing out of my presentable clothes and invariably I will leave my studio with a touch of acrylic paint somewhere! A few weeks ago, I thought I had succeeded in keeping the paint off my shirt, but I must have brushed against my easel at some point because I had dried acrylic paint on the back of my shoulder. Ahhhh! It was one of my favorite shirts!

Well, I found a solution. I hand washed the spots with Murphy's Oil Soap and to my surprise, with a little rubbing and scraping I was able to remove all of the dried paint from the shirt. Not even a stain was left! I then washed the shirt with my regular wash, and you would never know it had been kissed with paint at all!
