Alignment: Agreement and Cooperation with God's Word

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity (Ps. 133:1)! We may not have ever met in this earthly realm, but we who have received Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord are a part of the same Body – the Body of Christ. As such, it is a joy to walk in fellowship with you and with the unity that is in Christ Jesus.

What a blessing and a privilege to be able to share the following testimony with you, for we overcome by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of our testimony (Rev. 12:11), amen?
Amen!

God has blessed me to accomplish many things this past month... things that I could not have imagined myself accomplishing – especially in so short a time. There were big projects that I had been putting off or had put down altogether because they seemed too overwhelming. The small steps that I had taken to complete them seemed of no effect because by the time I was ready to move forward, the effects of those small steps had expired, and I had to do them again. I felt like I was getting nowhere.

THEN God blessed me with a priceless treasure in Ephesians 3:8. Paul was explaining to the Ephesians how God called him and equipped him to preach to the Gentiles. In verse 8, Paul said, “Grace alone empowers me so that I can boldly preach this wonderful message to non-Jewish people...” (The Passion Translation). The Holy Spirit quickened the words to me, “***Grace alone empowers me so that I can.***” Not my skill. Not my talent. Not my ability. Not my resources. Only my willingness to come into alignment with this Word, *allowing* his Grace to empower me.

Grace alone empowers me so that I can. Because it is God's grace that empowers me, **I can.** *Relying on and appropriating God's grace, there is no way that I cannot.* I took hold of that Word. I immediately came into alignment with that Word.

When the project looked too big, impossible, or overwhelming, I chose to cooperate with the Word that God had given me: Grace alone empowers me so that **I can.** I acted in agreement with the Word that God had given me: *God has supplied me with the strength and ability to do this. Let's get-er-done!* I aligned myself with God's Word and applied it to my life: *Grace alone*

empowers me so that I can... so that I can do this project. So that I can go to all of my meetings at work. So that I can write the next part of my dissertation. So that I can design the website. So that I can minister at The Prayer Corner. So that I can pay my bills. So that I can resist this temptation.

God blessed me with a fresh revelation where Philippians 4:13 is concerned: “I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ’s sufficiency] (AMPC). And guess what?

- Not only did I complete a project I was working on, but I’ve got a system for it to be perpetuated.
- Not only did I go to all my meetings, but my supervisors began to look to me for answers, plans, and strategies; AND used my work as an example to their trainees, requiring them to format their work the same way.
- Not only did I write the next part of my dissertation, but it has been approved and now I am writing the NEXT part of my dissertation.
- Not only did I design the website, but I uncovered errors with the program that caused the ministry to be reimbursed for the three months that we had paid AND to be awarded a 50% discount for the next three months.
- Not only did I minister at The Prayer Corner, but I have received instruction about how to orchestrate The Prayer Corner in the next season.
- Not only did I pay my bills, but I had surplus in my account.
- Not only have I resisted the temptation, but I find it easier to resist every day!

*Give God praise!!!
Grace alone empowered me!*

Understand, I am not taking credit for these blessings. But I am thinking, walking, and believing from an elevated place. I see myself as one with Jesus. I see that it is He Who is living through me and causing these things to come to pass. I can say like Paul, “...the Anointed One lives His life through me – we live in union as one! My new life is empowered by the faith¹ of the Son of God Who loves me so much that He gave Himself for me, and dispenses His life into mine!” (Gal. 2:20, The Passion Translation).

I believe these awesome manifestations took place because I came into alignment with God’s Word. **Alignment** with God’s Word allows you and others to see the reality of grace in your life. The reality of grace is the **perfection** (maturation, completeness, and fullness) of God’s plan being manifested in your life. Seeing this perfection come to pass in your life will increase your confidence of Who God is in you and who you are in Him, causing you to experience **elevation**: engaging in a higher order of thinking – seeing yourself as one with Jesus, seated at the right hand of the Father, walking in the same power and authority as the Son of God.

I pray that you have been blessed, encouraged, and challenged by this testimony. I speak blessing over you:

Every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realm has already been lavished upon us as a love gift from our wonderful heavenly Father, the Father of our Lord Jesus – all because He sees us wrapped into Christ . This is why we celebrate Him with all our hearts!

(Eph 1:3, The Passion Translation)

May you receive every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realm manifested to you in here in the earth. May you receive every love gift that your wonderful heavenly Father has lavished upon you. May you see yourself as He sees you – wrapped into Christ. May you celebrate Him with all your hearts by walking worthy (taking full advantage) of this good life that He has already prepared and made ready (i.e., perfected) for you to live (Eph 2:10, AMPC).
