

Congratulations to **Glenn Davies** for claiming the **May Monthly Medal** with **62 Nett,** including birdies on the par 3 5th & 10th.


Glenn claimed the medal over Paul Monaghan, who carded a 64 Nett.

Tea/Coffee & Gold Coin Donations

Another outcome from the May Committee Meeting was to put in place a gold coin donation system for Members who wish to enjoy a tea or coffee prior to, or post round. The complimentary tea & coffee has been a staple of Saturday competitions for a period of time, however, with our fields significantly increasing over the last 12 months the costs associated with continuing this needed to be recovered by the club. Any donations received will be used to offset the costs with any money left over being donated to support the Paterson Psst! newsletter. Thank you to the Veterans who have agreed to put forward \$20 on a weekly basis towards the tea & coffee supplies.

Tree Maintenance

Works were completed to remove one of the trees to the west of the 3rd green. Thanks to Peter Griffin who assisted in removal of the tree along with a number of our volunteers with the clean up process. Whilst the debris is cleaned up the areas impacted have been marked as Ground Under Repair.

Grant Update

Whilst somewhat delayed with a change of Government, our successful grant application has progressed with documents being signed & the first instalment of funds anticipated to be received in the short term.

Social Playing Fees Increase
From 1st July 2023 our social playing fees will increase to \$20 for visitors & \$10 for Members & Juniors (u18). The fee increase is in response to the rising cost of operations & is also more reflective of the condition of the course which has continually improved over

recent years.

The half yearly Eclectic Competition continues in the background of each weekly Open Competition. The Eclectic Competition is split into 2 Divisions with the respective winners & runner ups allocated a value to their prize account at the end of June & December.

The Eclectic Competition calculates the lowest score scored by each player in every round they participate in to calculate a cumulative best round throughout the period with your lowest handicap during the period being adjusted to 50% to determine a Nett score.

2023/2024 MEMBERSHIP PACKAGES

2023/2024 Membership Packages are in the process of being distributed to our existing Members via mail or collection at the Clubhouse when in operation.

In the graphic (*right*) our 2023/24 Membership categories are displayed; Paterson Golf Club offers some of the most competitive & affordable membership across the Hunter region. Join today & start to enjoy the benefits this great country club has to offer!

Membership has been increased from \$260 to \$280 (Standard Membership Fee) & from \$400 to \$450 (Gold Membership Fee) annually following due consideration by the committee. Our Membership fees were frozen during 2022/23 due to the ongoing impact of inclement weather & inability to use the course, however, with costs across the board continuing to rise, a minor increase was deemed appropriate in the current climate.

The Membership fees collected by Paterson Golf Club are distributed into several different streams which include Golf Australia & Golf NSW which allow Members to enjoy the benefits of the national GolfLINK system which manages your handicap. Affiliation fees are also forwarded for each Member to the Hunter River District Golf Association which provides opportunities for Members to participate in District events including the Order of Merit & also into the Pennants Series across multiple grades.

Paterson Golf Club retains the remaining fees which is used across the club to fund activities on the course including machinery maintenance, as well as the other ongoing costs such as chemicals, fuel, electricity, water & our competition management software.

Paterson Golf Club remains committed to providing an affordable membership for Members whilst ensuring the rising costs of managing a golf course are maintained.



To be read in conjunction with Association By Laws

- A team shall consist of two (2) players. The Team handicap shall be one quarter (1/4) of the aggregate of the two (2) handicaps. The event shall be played in two (2) divisions, in number one (1) division the Team handicap limit shall be from scratch to six (0 6), and in the number two (2) division the Team handicap shall be from six and one quarter to thirteen and one half (6 1/4 13 1/2). The maximum individual handicap is 36 strokes.
- To win the division 1 or Division 2 championship, both players must be members of a club affiliated with the Hunter River District Golf Association.
- 3. Each Team will select a Captain, before commencing play.
- Each individual player's name and handicap <u>MUST</u> be shown on the score card.
- 5. Preferred lies, within one (1) Club length, no nearer the hole, are permitted through the green. The ball may be cleaned.
- 6. Ties, for all trophies, will be decided by Count-back, as defined in the Golf Australia Handbook.
