We will also review telling time to the hour. I cannot believe how quickly December is approaching! The December reading logs are on the back of the November reading logs. 1st/2nd: I hope everyone had a great Thanksgiving break. This week we are back hard at work. First grade will have a math test on Tuesday and a spelling test on Friday. Second grade will have a math test on Thursday and spelling test on Friday. Both grades will begin new science units this week focusing more on Earth science. Second grade will also begin working on uppercase letters in cursive. **AR tests are due by December 10**, which is less than 2 weeks away. 3rd/4th: Welcome back everyone! I hope you all had a wonderful Thanksgiving. This week, our class will get back into our regular routine. Both classes will have a math test on Thursday. Fourth grade will have a science test over chapter 6 on Friday. In Social Studies, we will continue working on our Missouri Studies Weekly. I plan to have a test over week 8 sometime early next week. Please let me know, if you have any questions. - **Mrs. Cooper**

5th/6th: I hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving! In Writing, 5th graders will be writing some Christmas Acrostic poems and 6th grade will be writing Christmas shape poems. In Science, 5th grade will start a new chapter about "Weather" and 6th grade will begin a new chapter on "Elements". In Reading, students will be looking at chapters 15-17 in our Lit. Circle book "The Egypt Game". In Social Studies, 5th graders will read Ch. 2 "From a New Nation to

a Divided Nation" and 6th grade will look at Ch. 3 "The Age of Exploration". 5th graders will have a states and capitals test over #1-50 on Friday. AR Book Requirements for 5th-8th graders are due Friday, December 10th. - Mrs. Foster

7th/8th: I hope everybody had a nice break! In social studies, seventh grade will be finishing a chapter dealing with early empires in Asia and the Americas before moving on to events in European history prior to the time of exploration. In eighth grade, students are studying the early efforts to begin the United States after the American Revolution. In math, 7th grade is working on ratio story problems and more difficult order-of-operations problems. In pre-algebra, students are working on area and perimeter of semicircles and addition and subtraction of small numbers. In algebra, students will be working on operations with polynomials and part/whole problems. **Tests This Week: Algebra: Friday, Pre-Algebra: Thursday, 7th and 8th Social Studies: Friday 5/6 Math:** In fifth grade, students will be naming and performing operations with larger numbers, looking at circle measures and problem-solving strategies with word problems. In sixth grade, students will be working with prime factorizations, various topics involving mixed numbers and classifying quadrilaterals. **Tests This Week: 5th and 6 Math Test: Friday - Mr. Ewing**

MUSIC: Keep practicing! We will sing without background vocals and lyrics starting this week!

CHARACTER ED WORD: CITIZENSHIP – fulfilling civic and social responsibilities and contributing to the well-being of the communities in which you are a member -- We will wrap up citizenship this week and begin talking about **Caring**. We all seem to be a lot more caring this time of year. I will work with the students to show them how to be caring all year long!
