## Things to Consider for Wisdom\_1

Studying the Bible that is the word of God helps us see wisdom from God of "what not to do".

Studying history allow us see how well anyone listened.

- Thou shalt have none other gods before (or ahead of) me. (There is only one God. He is not created, but He is the Creator. It is He that is the Father and God of the Lord Jesus Christ. But the human race, even today's smartest societies, goes about creating/inventing gods, which is devoid of help and the people perish).
- Thou shalt not make thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the waters beneath the earth: (even man is but an image of the true and living God. Thus, there may perhaps remain unknowable mysteries of God, even in the resurrected life? There is none like Him, and total comprehension of him may not be possible!? In other words, we should consider that there may always be aspects of our relationship with God which must be in FAITH according to the expression(s) given us through the Lord Jesus Christ. Even in the resurrected life we do not cease to be creations/ creatures of God, because we were not with him in the beginning; only the Son, Jesus was with him in the beginning?? See the Gospel of John, Chapter 1). Satan made the mistake of thinking himself equal with God!
- Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them (Idols, images/gods created of men, nor any creature, or creature(s) claiming to be God. Satan, the devil is a creature!), nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me (If the previous "1, 2, 3, ... generations" hated God, and this current generation also hates God, then the iniquity of the previous generations is upon the current generation. And they all shall receive like judgment from God),
- And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments (because God cares, and His commands are given because of His great love to keep us from that "eternal destruction").
- Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain (God is apart from all else, and there is no other as He; He is one of a kind. No one or nothing else has his qualification and capability to meet the needs of His creation. Therefore, His creatures are disrespectful, as well as disobedient, when speaking of Him in jest and out of disgust. God is Holy!).

Keep the sabbath day to sanctify it, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee. Six days thou shalt labour, and do all thy work:

But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou (*no matter how technologically advanced societies may become, people should still rest, at least one day a week).* 

- And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of (Old Testament) Egypt (the New Testament, "world"), and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm (Old Testament Moses; New Testament Jesus): therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day. (The Apostle Paul said it this way):
- Heb 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)
- Heb 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works (*pleasing to God*):
- Heb 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some *is;* but exhorting *one another:* and so much the more (*or assemble together more*), as ye see the day (*end time*) approaching.
- Heb 10:26 For if we sin willfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, (in other words do not say, "I will do this sin now and ask God for forgiveness later. Even the saved shall lose reward(s)!")

Honour thy father and thy mother, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee; that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee (the path of all existence(s) trace back to God. Therefore, despising who you are, your origin, or someone else's origins is a criticism against God; that He is incompetent, or without wisdom. And you, the creature is qualified to council even God).

## Commandments that should need no explanation:

Thou shalt not kill.

Neither shalt thou commit adultery.

Neither shalt thou steal.

Neither shalt thou bear false witness against thy neighbour.

Neither shalt thou desire thy neighbour's wife, neither shalt thou covet thy neighbour's house, his field, or his manservant, or his maidservant, his ox, or his ass, or any *thing* that *is* thy neighbour's.

Deuteronomy 5:7 - 5:21

Sometimes it seems even the dedicated Christians (followers of the Lord Jesus Christ) believe God has changed his mind about these commandments. But nothing could be further from the truth, and just because people can not, or will not do as God commanded, doesn't mean God changed his mind. Thus, disobedience to commandments from the LORD God Almighty comes out of us all. And without forgiveness through Christ Jesus, and him crucified, we are taken by eternal destruction!
