SCENE 1

Narrator One – part 1:

Shalom children! We are going to share with you the miracle of how Yahshua, our Messiah was born, from the bible books of Matthew and Luke!

Narrator Two – part 1:

The cherub Gabriel was sent from the presence of Elohim, to the city called Nazareth. He was sent to Mariam, a virgin who was betrothed to a man named Joseph, from the house of David.

The cherub said to her...

Gabriel – part 1:

Peace to you full of grace! Our Adonai is with you. You are blessed among women!

Do not fear, Mariam, for you have found grace from YAHWEH. For behold you will receive conception and bear a son and you will call His name Yahshua. This One will be great and will be called Son of the Most High. And YAHWEH Elohim will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob to the ages, and of His kingdom there will be no end.

Mariam – part 1: (to the cherub)

How will this be, since I do not know a man?

Gabriel – part 2:

The Holy Spirit will come and the power of the Highest will rest upon you. Because of this, He who is to be born of you is holy and will be called the Son of YAHWEH.

Behold! Your kinswoman Elizabeth! She also conceived a son in her old age. For nothing shall be impossible with YAHWEH!

Mariam – part 2:

Behold, I am the handmaid of YAHWEH. Let it be to me according to your word!

Narrator One – part 2:

The cherub departed from her presence. Mariam rose up and entered into the house of Zacharias and she greeted Elizabeth.

SCENE 2

Elizabeth – part 1:

You are being blessed among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb! Why is this to me that the mother of my Adonai comes to me? For behold, as the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the babe in my womb leaped in exultation. Blessed is she believing, because there will be a fulfillment to the things spoken to her from YAHWEH.

Mariam – part 3:

My soul magnifies YAHWEH, and my spirit exulted in Elohim My Savior. Because He has looked at the meekness of His handmaid for behold from now on He will give me blessings to all generations. Because He has done great things for me, He who is mighty and Holy is His Name. And His mercy is to generations of generations to those fearing Him.

He performed mightily with His arm; He scattered proud ones in the thought of their heart. He put down powerful ones from thrones, and exalted lowly ones. He filled the hungry with good things, and He sent the rich away empty. He helped His servant Israel in order to remember mercy, even as He spoke to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed.

Narrator Two – part 2:

Mariam remained with Elizabeth about three months, and returned to her house.

SCENE 3

Narrator One – part 3:

Now it happened in those days that a decree went out from Augustus Caesar that the names of all the people where he ruled, should be written down.

Narrator Two – part 3:

Joseph also went to the city of David which is called Bethlehem, to be registered with Mariam the one having been betrothed to him as wife, she being pregnant.

Joseph did not want to make her a public example and he thought to divorce her secretly. As he was thinking about these things, a Cherub of YAHWEH was seen by him in a dream...

Cherub – part 3:

Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mariam as your wife. For that in her is generated by the Holy Spirit. And she will bear a son, and you shall call His name Yahshua, for He shall save His people from their sins.

And all this happened so that might be fulfilled that which was spoken by YAHWEH through the prophet, saying, "Behold! The virgin will conceive in her womb and will bear a son, and they will call His name Emmanuel," which is interpreted, our Elohim with us.

Narrator One – part 4:

Joseph woke up from his sleep and did as the cherub of YAHWEH commanded him.

It so happened, Mariam bore her son, the Firstborn. She wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in the manger, because there was no room where they could lodge.

SCENE 4

Narrator Two – part 4:

Now, Herod was the king of Judea in this time and the magi arrived from the east to Jerusalem asking where the King of the Jews was born. For they saw His star in the east and came to worship Him.

Herod heard this and he was troubled and all Jerusalem with him. He gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people and asked where the Messiah was to be born.

Secretly calling the magi, he asked them the exact time they saw the star. He sent them to Bethlehem to find out about the Child. When they found the Child, they were to return and bring him word so he could worship Him.

Narrator One – part 5:

Having heard the king, the magi departed. And, behold! The star which they saw in the east went before them until it had come and stood over where the Child was.

Seeing the star, the maji rejoiced exceedingly with a great joy! They came to the house and saw the Child with His mother Mariam. Falling down, they worshiped Him. They opened their treasures, and they presented gifts to Him, gold and frankincense and myrrh. They were warned by a dream not to return to Herod, so they went back into their own country by another way.

SCENE 5

Narrator Two – part 5:

The shepherds were in the same region living in the fields and keeping guard over their flock by night. And, behold, a cherub of Elohim came on them. And the glory of YAHWEH shone around them. They feared with a great fear.

Cherub – part 4:

Do not fear. For, behold, I proclaim good news to you, a great joy, which will be to all the world, For today is born to you in the city of David, the Savior, who is YAHWEH, the Messiah.

And this is a sign to you: You will find an infant having been wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in the manger.

Narrator One – part 6:

Suddenly, there was with the cherub a multitude of the heavenly host, praising YAHWEH and saying, Glory to YAHWEH in the highest, and peace on earth, good will among men!

And it happened as the cherubs departed from them, into the heaven, the shepherds, said to one another...

Shepherds – part 1:

Let us go over to Bethlehem, and see this thing occurring, which YAHWEH made known to us.

Narrator Two – part 6:

Hurrying, they came and sought out both Mariam and Joseph, and the Babe lying in the manger. Seeing, they publicly told about the word spoken to them about this Child.

The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising YAHWEH for all things which they heard and saw, even as was spoken to them.

SCENE 6

Narrator One – part 7:

A Cherub of YAHWEH appeared to Joseph by a dream, saying...

Cherub – part 5: (to Joseph)

Rise up! Take the child and His mother with you, and flee into Egypt. Be there until I shall tell you. Herod is about to look for the child in order to destroy Him.

Narrator Two – part 7:

So, Rising up, Joseph took along the child and His mother by night and went into Egypt. He was there until the end of Herod, that might be fulfilled that spoken by YAHWEH through the prophet, saying, "Out of Egypt I have called My Son."

Narrator One – part 8:

Herod saw that he was mocked by the magi and he was greatly enraged. He sent to kill all the boys in Bethlehem, and in all its districts, from two years old and under, according to the time which he exactly asked from the magi.

When King Herod was dead, a Cherub of YAHWEH appeared to Joseph by a dream in Egypt, saying, to rise up and take along the child and His mother and pass over into the land of Israel; for those seeking the life of the child have died.

Narrator Two – part 8:

So, Joseph rose up and took along the child and His mother and came into the land of Israel. But, hearing that Archelaus reigned over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there. Being warned by a dream, he went into the land of Galilee. He lived in a city called Nazareth, to fulfill that spoken by the prophet, “He shall be called a Nazarene”.

Narrator One – part 9:

Halleluyah! We hope you enjoyed learning how our Messiah Yahshua was born, as it was written and foretold by the prophets in the scriptures. Yahweh loved us so much He sent His only Son, Yahshua, to be born into this world, as a man, to take away our sins.
