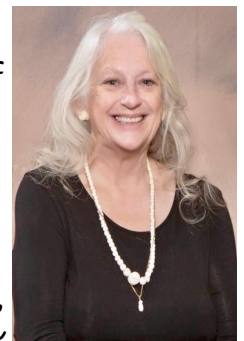

Mrs. Jenelin Holder

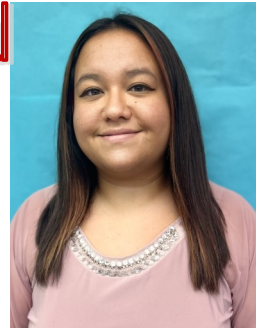
Preschool Teacher Aide
