Breeding Ewes 31 older breeding ewes forward for sale sold to a top of £87 for Mr M Wright for 2 Lleyn breeding ewes. 15 Exmoor Horn 1^{st} and 2^{nd} Yr FM Ewes from R G Tucker hit £70.

Breeding Rams saw a strong demand and topped for three Bluefaced Leicesters from R G Tucker at £410, with a Chartex from E J & R J Mills to £400 and a second to £380 and Charollais from D & G Baker topped at £340 twice.

Store Lambs A tremendous show of store lambs again this week met with another flying trade to average at £71.97. A top of the day at £84.20 for S Ellicott, who followed up with a further pen of 10 to £84. C Raffe saw his pen of 34 away at £83, equalled by pens from S McCracken, M Rawle, Coombe Farm Partnership, Rackenford Manor Farms with E J Ellicott closely following with a pen of 4 to £82.80, equalled by a pen of 16 from P J Delbridge and a second pen from C Raffe at £82.20. Demand continues extremely strong and the store lambs seem to be outstripping the fat price, with many lambs seemingly 38-40kg making over the £80 mark.
