Scholarship Requirements

Following are scholarship requirements for students to be considered for the Early Childhood Math Development Foundation after-school math program:

Parent or Guardian Requirements

1. Parent or guardian must commit to being an active participant in the after-school supplemental math education of their student and have an interest in securing funds for future supplemental after-school math education.
2. Parent or guardian must be able to provide transportation to the assigned after-school math program location two days a week for a minimum 30-minute class.
3. Parent or guardian must have student complete daily math homework assignments (approximately 30 minutes) at home at least five days a week.
4. Parent or guardian must check the student's daily math homework assignments at home and have the child make all corrections. If a parent or guardian needs help checking a student's math homework, ECMDF will provide assistance.
5. Parent or guardian must provide to ECMDF a copy of the student's State/National Standards Test Score results administered by the student's public school. This test score record must be given to ECMDF before a scholarship can be awarded to the student to attend an after-school math program. Test scores will report the student's performance level in Math, English, and Language Arts in the following performance levels:
 - Below Basic
 - Basic
 - Proficient
 - Advanced
6. The assigned supplemental after-school math program provider will provide regular performance level reports to ECMDF and the parent or guardian for all students.
