Definition of Terms

Amateur – Hobbyist only, with two years or less experience
Open – Open to anyone who does not make money on their craft
Professional – Teacher/Instructor or anyone who derives any income from their craft
Senior Citizen – Entry must have been made by person 62 years or older
Adult – Entry must have been made by person 18 years or older
Antiques – Any article entered must be at least 50 years or older
Exceptional – Limited mental capacity or physical disability

- Items of offensive, controversial or objectionable nature or subject matter may not be accepted.
- Fair management holds final decision on judging and displaying of all entries if they are over a certain.
- Exhibits must dry before they will be accepted by the Tulsa State Fair.
- Only artwork and oil paintings must be framed for suitable hanging no sawtooths.
- All work must have been made within one year of the 2017 fair
- ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO ONE PER CLASS. You may enter as many classes as you would like.
- Artwork and Oil Paintings
 - o Need to have a hanging wire on the back of the frame.
 - o Cannot exceed 30" x 30", including frame
- Exceptional Division
 - o Limited mental capacity or physical disability.
- Glassblowing
 - Beginner 5 years or less experience
 - o Advanced 6 to 9 years of experience
 - Master 10 or more years of experience
- Hand-Painted Porcelain
 - No seminar pieces accepted.
 - Novice 3 years or less experience
 - Advanced More than 3 years of experience
 - o Professional Open to teachers & those who sell their artwork
- Leather Crafting
 - Any individual having won 5 or more blue ribbons in Leather Crafting at the Tulsa State Fair must enter in the Open Division. A Sweepstakes ribbon counts as two blue ribbons.
 - Individuals may enter the Open Division even if they have not participated at the Novice level.
- Native American Arts & Crafts
 - o Items must have been made within the past year.
 - Artifacts may not be entered.
- Rubber Stamping
 - o Use rubber stamps, embellishments, ribbons, fibers, brads, charms, eyelets, etc.
 - No stickers.
 - No peel and stick items.

Scrapbooking

- Must be 12" x 12" page in protective sleeve. The Tulsa State Fair will be pinning up your pages using protected sleeves.
- All items including photos must be computer generated for digital scrapbook pages.
- o Canvas must not exceed 30" x 30", any shape allowed.
- Shadow Boxes or Boxed Scrapbooking not to exceed 30" x 30", any shape allowed.

Wood Items

o Entries must be constructed predominately of wood.

- This division is open to anyone 62 years of age and over.
- Entries must have been made within the last two years and made entirely by the exhibitor.
- Sweepstakes awards will only be awarded in divisions where five (5) or more entries are being judged.
- Photographs
 - o Must be 8" x 10" or 8" x 11" with 11" x 14" matte.
 - o Must be matted with single matting. No double mattes will be accepted.
 - o Matting must not be thicker than 3/8".
 - o No foam boards.
 - o No frames.
- Quilts
 - o Must have been made in the last two years by one person.
- Wood
 - o Entries are to be constructed predominately of wood.
- Hanging Art
 - o Must be framed with some kind of wire or hook on the back
 - No Sawtooths
 - o Not to exceed 30" x 30", including frame.

Rules and Regulations Governing all Competitive Exhibits Sections Adult and Junior Divisions

- For assistance or questions on entering your exhibit, you may call the Competitive Exhibits Office at (918) 744-1113 Ext. 2080
- Exhibitors must comply with all rules and regulation of the Tulsa State Fair and work must be completed by the Exhibitor only.
- Do not leave sacks, supplies or other material used to transport your exhibit.
- Entries must be entered online or on a Tulsa State Fair Entry Form.
- ONLY ONE ENTRY PER CLASS; NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.
- No exhibitor will be allowed to interfere in any way with the Superintendent or Judge in the performance of their duties. A violation of this rule will be excluded from the exhibition. Superintendents have been instructed to reclassify an entry if it does not fit the classification entered by the exhibitor. Any questions or concerns should be directed to Amanda Bretz, Artistic Programs Coordinator, at abretz@exposquare.com.
- All photographs must have name, division and class marked on the back of each photo.
 Names will be covered during judging.
- The Tulsa State Fair will not take responsibility for the mailing of items; items must be brought and picked up in person during the designated dates and times.
- Management reserves the right to exclude from the exhibit any article it deems unworthy
 or inappropriate. After judging, the Tulsa State Fair reserves the privilege of displaying
 articles, or in the case there is not adequate space they reserve the right of setting the
 articles back for the exhibitor to pick up at the conclusion of the fair.
- All judging in the Competitive Exhibits Adult & Junior Divisions will be completed before the fair opens; however placement will not be given out over the phone.
- All photographs taken of exhibitors, demonstrators, and entries become property of the Tulsa State Fair and may be used for promotional reasons.
- Tulsa State Fair Competitive Exhibits employees are not permitted to exhibit in any department in which they are employed.
- Sweepstakes awards will only be awarded in divisions where five (5) or more entries are being judged.
- Sweepstakes awards are left to judge's discretion.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winning entries may not be entered in future years after winning any Competitive Exhibits or Contest award. If an item is entered that has previously won is entered in the competition, fair staff has the right to disqualify the entry.
