



Our first "ancestral chart" to be published in the BOYLE BULLetin is, naturally, my own. It consists of three parts: 1) the chart, 2) photos of ancestors, and 3) some vital statistics. I would encourage other readers to send in similar charts. They will be published as space permits. I owe much of the above information to my grandmother, Mary (Taylor) Boyle [AID=BDCA(S)], who was very active in helping to compile the family trees for the Forests, the Stringers, the Davises, and the Taylors. I recall asking her once why she never did the Boyle tree and she said she didn't have the time to do a good job. I'm beginning to understand this as I find the time scarce working on one tree. There are tenuous suggestions that John STEWART (87) is descended from a first cousin of Bonnie Prince Charlie. The published evidence is rumoured to exist in a book called "The history of Armagh" or "Tales of Armagh" or something like that. However the book was published in a limited edition over a hundred years ago and no one I know of has seen it or seen a direct quote from it.

I believe Catherine McINTYRE is the daughter of Peter McINTYRE (91) although I have yet to find the proof. Peter McINTYRE emigrated to Canada with Chief Archibald McNab around 1826. He played an active role in the rebellion against the Laird of McNab and his feudalistic practices. Henry Boyle on Pakenham mountain and Peter McIntyre in White Lake were practically neighbours. They also likely suffered some of the same hardships in trying to eke a living out of the same inhospitable soil.

I am still hunting for Catherine's marriage and death and surely somebody in that country knows something. I agree with you that Catherine is probably buried in or around Deacon. There is almost sure to be more information around Wilberforce Township, Pembroke and Eganville regarding Henry Boyle and that school [on his property] but, I do not have much access to this data.

A couple of additions to your own data. Henry's daughter Elizabeth, known as Liza (AID=BH) died in 1932 and is buried in Maple Leaf, Ontario. George Davis is buried beside her and I took a picture of the headstone which I will get one of these days. Edward (AID=BI) is buried in Purdy, in the old cemetery but there is no headstone. This data I checked out with Delbert Davis, who knew Edward and who helped dig his grave. Delbert is about 77 years old and lives in Maple Leaf. He has a number of interesting stories about Edward.
