Summary of Covenants – Glenhurst Subdivision

- 1. Your driveway is to be only as wide as the number of garages you have. No extra space for additional cars is allowed.
- 2. Any storage building must be built of same type building and roofing material as your house, with a maximum eave height of 6'6". They are allowed in the back yard area as long as the back yard area is enclosed by a sight proof fence. Architecture Committee approval is required.
- 3. No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind are allowed. Exceptions are dogs, cats, or other household animals. Animal breeding is not permitted. No Pit Bull dogs.
- 4. Boats or trailers may be kept on premises only as long as not visible from another lot.
- 5. Cars parked in the driveway overnight cannot exceed the number of garages.
- 6. All shrubs, trees, grass, and plants shall be neatly trimmed, properly cultivated, and free of trash, weeds, and other unsightly material. Dead landscaping and trees must be replaced by homeowner.
- 7. Garbage cans shall not be seen from any street. The cans shall be stored in the garage or behind a site proof fence. They can be placed on the curb the evening before pickup and stored no later than the evening of the pickup day.

- 8. Any new or replacement fence, roof, structure, swimming pool, or any remodeling must be submitted to Architectural Committee for approval.
- 9. No tree house or antennae shall be visible to neighboring property. One child's outdoor play structure (such as play tower, swing set, or trampoline) is allowed to stick up above a minimum six-foot high site proof fence providing that it cannot be seen from the street in front of the house.
- 10. A satellite dish may be placed on the roof at the rear of the house, providing it cannot be seen from the street in front of the home.
- 11. Basketball goals cannot be permanently installed.
 Portable basketball goals are allowed so long as stored in garage or out of sight when not in use.
- 12. No building or improvement upon any lot shall be permitted to fall into disrepair.
