Henry County Youth Football League

A. League Rules

a. General

- i. Games that are cancelled will be rescheduled if possible. Make up dates will be agreed upon by both coaches and commissioner.
- ii. Games that affect the outcome of team positions in the league must be played.
- iii. If a tie occurs at the end of the regular season, it will be broken as follows: head to head record, head to head score, and then overall points for the season.
- iv. The board must approve anyone interested in coaching and have an approved background check.
- v. Referees that have children participating cannot call that game.
- vi. The head referee's decision will be final with no intimidation by any coach or parent.
- vii. Two coaches will be allowed on the field at the Peewee Level, Up to 2 at the JV Level and none at the Varsity Level. Coaches on the field must remain 5 yards back from the deepest player/referee and cannot coach once the ball is snapped.
- viii. Protest or disputes on rule violation must be voiced immediately following the game and presented to the board in writing within three (3) days after the game for review. The board will have the final say.
- ix. All games will follow the KHSAA Official Rule Book unless otherwise stated.
- x. The board must approve suspensions of more than one game.
- xi. Any trick/deceiving play must be reported and cleared to the referees before the game.
- xii. Full refunds will only be given in the case of a written medical release once all equipment is turned it to the league or the coach. Cut off day for refunds is Jam Day.
- xiii. There will be no players admitted to the league after the first game unless cleared by the board.
- xiv. Players will be Kindergarten through 6th grade ages; no one can turn 13 years of age before November 1st season year. No 7th Graders will be allowed to play. Players may only fail the same grade once.
- xv. Home team gets to decide which side of the field they would like to stand on.
- xvi. Practices prior to the start of school will not exceed eight (8) hours per week and no one practice will last longer than two (2) hours.
- xvii. Practices during the school calendar will not exceed four (4) hours per week and no practice will last longer than two (2) hours.
