
## Whistle Stop Ranch Riding Club (WSRRC) Awards How to Qualify for Highpoint & Reserve Awards

Join the Whistle Stop Ranch Riding Club (WSRRC)! Shows and points earned prior to joining WSRRC will NOTcount.
WSRRC 2023 show dates are: 4/29/2023 and 6/17/2023; both are double-judged shows.



- 2) Obtain a copy of the **2023** WSRRC High Point Categories & Rules and read them. If you have any questions, contact the WSRRC Show Director, Robbin Nail Housch or email: **achrcmail@gmail.com**.
- 3) In the WSRRC High Point Categories, find your category to see what classes count toward that category's awards.
- 4) For the points to count, you must:
  - Obtain a membership with WSRRC
  - Show the same horse in the same class in at least two (2) of the four (4) WSRRC shows.
  - Points from all 4 shows will count, so show more for more chances to obtain points.
  - Points from classes not shown in at least two (2) times (two of the four WSRRC shows) will NOT count toward highpoint/reserve. (One double-judge show counts as two shows.)
