\$49 Entry Fee and a minimum of Two Sponsor Cards are also required for every contestant.



**FUN FASHION** PERSONAL INTRO. FORMAL WALK ON-STAGE INTERVIEW

- Fun Fashion is an upbeat stage walk to provided music in your fun fashion outfit. Your fun fashion outfit of choice should highlight the color of a specific cancer awareness ribbon.
  - Your outfit can be formal, high fashion, creative, or costume-like just make sure it is accessorized & fabulous!
  - Hot tip: make sure your outfit is well-fitted and age-appropriate.
- Personal Intro remaining in your fun fashion outfit, you will give a short speech introducing yourself with your name, your hometown, and what color awareness ribbon you selected to highlight in your fun fashion outfit.
  - Hot tip: also include why you selected that special color (and/or ribbon) in your Personal Intro to show more authenticity and personality to the judges.

#### ===INTERMISSION=== (Time to change, if you wish, into your second outfit)

- Formal Walk is an elegant, slow, graceful walk, utilizing the full stage while having great stage presence and poise, making a full center turn in the center stage complete with a confident pose at the end.
- On-Stage Interview at end of your walk, you will join the interviewer on stage (in your formal wear) and answer 2-3 questions from the list provided in advance.

#### How do I prepare for the pageant?

Prepare for the pageant by raising your confidence level, practicing public speaking, and taking time to practice walking slowly and elegantly in the shoes and gown you'll wear for the "Formal Walk" at the pageant!

#### What are support cards?

Support cards are showcased in our 2022 Queen for a Cure Program Book, on HeartShine social media, and on our website for a full year. They are \$25 each for a business-card-sized spot. ### Is there a talent competition?



## There *is* a talent competition but it is *not* required!



For the Queen for a Cure live pageant, only four areas of competition go into deciding who will be our crowned royalty. These include (1) Fun Fashion, (2) Personal Intro, (3) Formal Walk, and (4) On-Stage Interview. All four of these are required of every contestant that day and their scores will decide who will be crowned "Queen for a Cure" in each age category.

A Talent extra opportunity awaits at Queen for a Cure! Those who want to perform Talent and compete in this fun Optional contest can enter for just \$10! Perform LIVE during the pageant and showcase your special skill for the judges in this fun addition to your HeartShine pageant experience.

"Optional" contests refer to additional competitions that are <u>not</u> <u>required</u> but provide additional opportunities to showcase a hobby or even try something new. By entering the Talent Optional (or any Optional) the contestant could earn additional prizes and recognition on stage during the crowning ceremony. However, entering Optionals will not increase your chances of winning the overall "Queen for a Cure/Heart for Hope" Queen title. "Optionals" are side-competitions with some really great prizes!

#### **Requirements for Talent entries:**

- under 2 minutes in length
- self-contained performance, no large props
- music submitted no less than 48 hrs ahead of the pageant through email (heartshinepageants@gmail.com) or via online form

#### Are there other "Optional Contests?"

Yes! Our other Optional Contests (\$10 each) are completed entirely online. They include Virtual Talent (video, work of art/poem, etc), Modeling (video), Short Essay (writing), and T-Shirt Design. More information about these Optional contests, including how to enter, will be included in your Contestant Packet #2!

## How do I find sponsors?

#### "Heart for Hope" Online Pageant

For those that can not attend the in-person pageant in Sacramento, the "Heart for Hope" pageant competition taking place completely online with an entry fee of just \$50.

When applications open on April 4th, you can complete your entry by uploading files directly to the online form. These uploads include one picture, a short paragraph, and one video. Refer to the list below for more complete information.

#### **Areas of Competition:**

- 1. Theme Photo
  - Upload a photo of you (the contestant) in at least one color that represents an awareness ribbon color for cancer
- 2. Short Essay
  - Just one short paragraph!
  - Tell the judges what color you choose to wear and what cancer awareness ribbon it represents. Share why this cause is important to you.
- 3. Formal Wear Walk
  - Record a short video
  - That can be in the same outfit as your theme photo or you can wear an elegant dress/attire.
- 4. Zoom 5 Minute Interview
  - Schedule a Zoom pageant interview with Ciara where you (the contestant) will be asked 2-3 questions provided in Contestant Packet #2

For virtual contestants not planning on attending the in-person pageant event on May 29th, the two support cards are not required.
