

Greater Module 5: Strike The Water

This Session's Key Idea: For each of us, there comes a time to step out on the word God has spoken to us about a greater life.

Questions:

- 1) Read 2 Kings 2:1-15, which records the pivotal moment when Elisha began to fulfill his prophetic calling on his own.
- 2) We all reach the same kind of critical decision point. What might your "strike the water" moment look like?
- 3) What remaining fears or questions do you still have about going after greater things? What hopes and expectations do you have?
- 4) Where do you see the Lord at work in your life right now?

My Action Step:

Crossing the Jordan River is an act that speaks of change, of leaving on life and entering another. Elisha crossed the literal Jordan River after striking the water with Elisha's cloak. You're crossing a kind of Jordan River too as you begin God's greater life for you.

Prayerfully consider how God wants you to strike the water, to begin your greater life. On a separate sheet of paper, write down what you are going to do.
