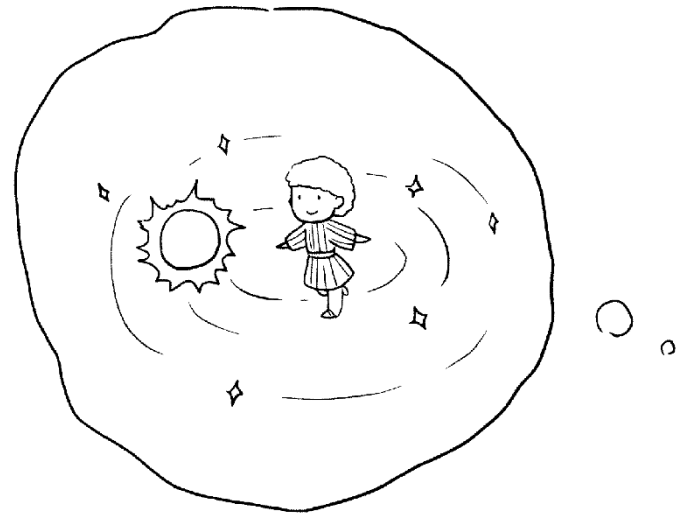
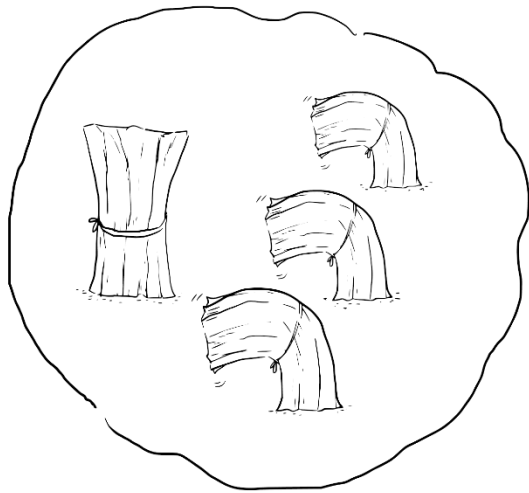


# Joseph's



# Dreams



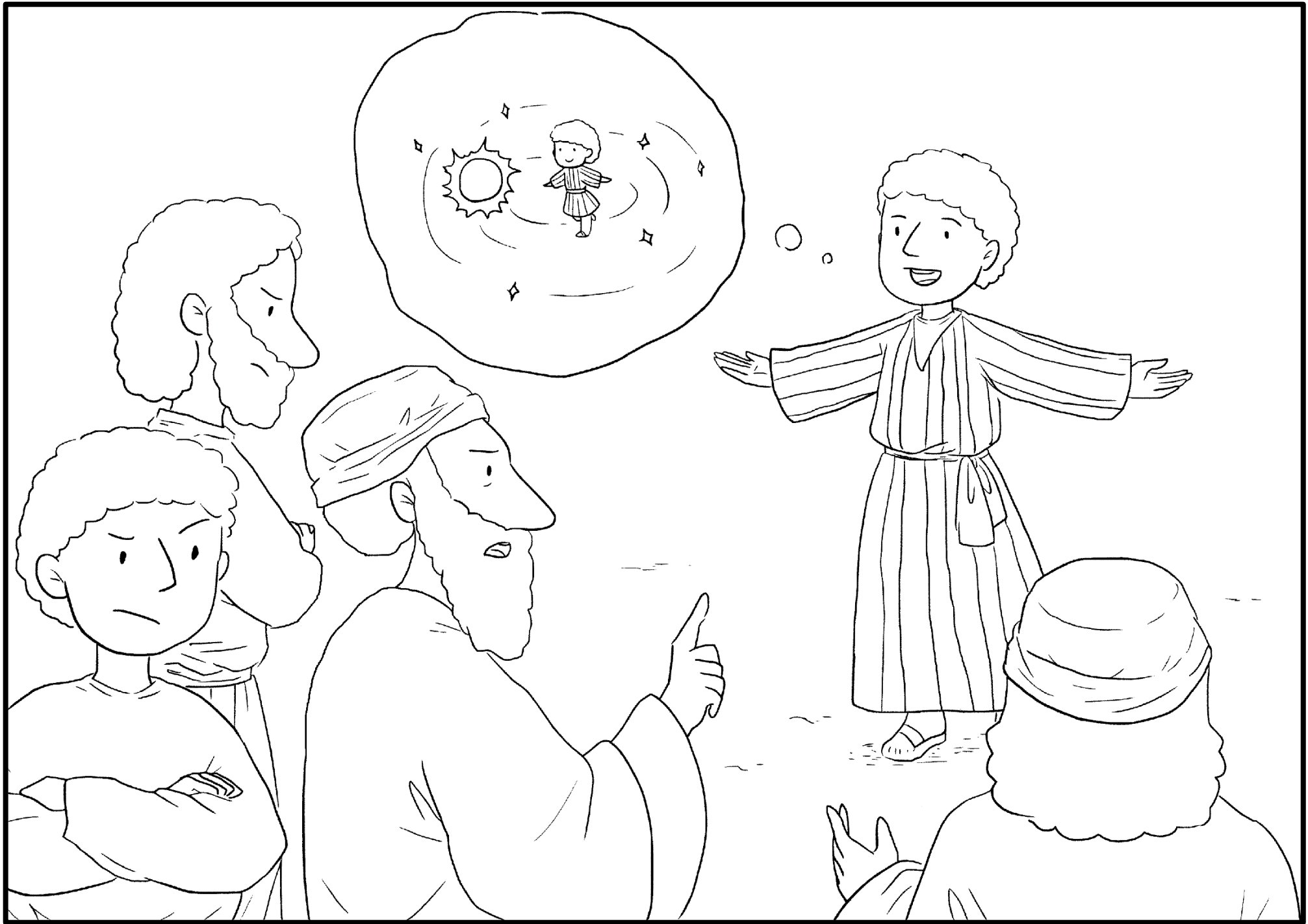
And Israel loved Joseph more than all his sons, because he was a son of old age to him. And he made a coat of many colors reaching to the feet – Genesis 37:3
