GIVE TO EVERYONE WHO ASKS

Luke 6:30 "Give to everyone who asks of you, and whoever takes away what is yours, do not demand it back."

Here we see one of Yeshua's greatest teaching to His people. This is a teaching of lifestyle. If you view that Yah is the supplier of all your needs, then you realize that He will provide for you all that is required to survive, all your needs. Knowing this means that your material things are really quite insignificant. We are not to be into material things, they will pass away, we are to be into spiritual understanding and truth which never passes away. Seek first the Kingdom of Yah. He is establishing the simple fact that if you think your stuff is necessary to meet your needs then you have a problem. Our life should never be bound up in "things". In other words, don't be concerned about worldly things, they are temporary, life in the kingdom is forever. Think of the lilies in the field, the sparrows, does He not provide them with all they need? The emphasis here is on trust. Do you trust that Yah will provide you will all your needs? You have Him to count on for all your needs. He is not saying give whatever you have to anyone who asks for it. We are not to think that "I gotta have this and I gotta have that", or I must "keep up with the Jones's".

He is not somehow justifying that someone can come along and take what is rightfully yours. That is taking it literally and missing the entire point of His deep teaching. DASYD Ministry
