LAWN ORNAMENTS: limited to two. Flowerpots – up to five in the bedding areas and walkways.

LEASING/RENTING: Must own the home for a year. Lease must be a minimum of six months.

PETS: All pets require approval. No more than two animals per home. Weight is not an issue – however, some breeds are. Refer to your documents for further clarification.

DECORATIVE DIS-PLAYS ON HOMES: Limited to two items. Must be located under the front porch and size limited to 30" x 30". Please look at your homeowner's guide – it is very informative.
