BIO -'LIFE TESTIMONY'

Reverend Steven Carter was called to teach and preach the word of God in his youth but it was only in 1993 that he truly acknowledged and embraced the call. This call to teach and preach the word of God is based on Acts 1:8, "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Steven has spent some time in preparation for the ministry. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Human Resources/Organizational Leadership from Geneva College (Center for Urban Theological Studies (CUTS)), Beaver Falls, PA., and a Masters of Science degree in Organizational Leadership from Philadelphia Biblical University (PBU), Langhorne, PA. In addition to ministry work and until his recent retirement, Steven worked as a director at a federal regulatory agency in the executive branch of government where he effectively applies leadership principles and personal ethics teachings that have their root in the bible.
