**Notes:**

1. Please be queued up socially distanced with your child on the blue playground on your allocated number as outlined above (1 – 30) at your allocated time
2. Please remain there until you are called.
3. You will be allowed to bring your child to their new classroom on this one day only and remain with them for ten minutes whilst they settle in. Experience shows that the sooner you leave, the quicker they will settle in and play with their new friends.
4. We would ask you to leave after ten minutes to allow the next group of children and their parents in.
5. You may take a photo of your own child if you so wish.
6. Whilst the wearing of a mask is not compulsory, for your own health and safety we would advise wearing a mask upon entering the school building.
7. The purpose of this day is to allow you (i) see your child's new classroom (ii) briefly say hello to your child's new teacher and (iii) to practice lining up
8. All children will be shown how to line up on their own by their class teacher during their first day. All children will be encouraged and expected to line up on their own from day 2.
9. **School will finish every day for junior infants at 12 midday till September 9<sup>th</sup>. From September 12<sup>th</sup> school will finish every day for junior infants at 2pm.**
