TREASURER'S REPORT

During the month of October, total bank deposits were \$13,428.35. The majority, \$12,099.50, came from your donations and pledges to our Move It Madness fundraising event. Total expenses paid out were \$8,446.88.

INCOME: In addition to the deposit made for Move It Madness donations, we also received several deposits for our Easy Money programs. The most significant amounts were \$492 for Jamba Juice sales and \$335.19 for flier nights.

EXPENSES: The majority of our October expenses were related to vendor payments for our Walk Thru California (\$1,790) and Walk Thru Revolution assemblies (\$2,040), as well as Harvest Festival expenses totaling \$2,059.53.

With our only scheduled fundraiser behind us, PTA will be reevaluating our financial situation based on its results. We will keep you informed! Thanks to everyone for all of your efforts to raise money for Move It Madness. Every dollar makes an impact and is greatly appreciated!

NOVEMBER 12-14 = NEXT FLYER NIGHT(S)


