Were You There?

The above is the title of a familiar Lenten hymn. The question is rhetorical in the sense that since the events considered took place roughly 1990 years ago, no one singing the hymn was physically present. The beauty of the hymn though is that in a sense we were there. Not in body of course! Our sin put Jesus in that particular location or locations. God's love for the sinner made those places locations for us to contemplate with a sense of gratitude.

In Adult Sunday School we are going to re-visit some of those locations: The Upper Room-where Jesus observed the Passover with the Twelve; The Garden of Gethsemane; The night court of the Sanhedrin; Before Pilate' The hill outside Jerusalem.
