## **MEETING REPORT**

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 13, 2022 at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all councillors present and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of December was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized the signing of water well lease agreements, acknowledged receipt of the Fidelity Bond, authorized workers compensation coverage, and set the 2022 wages and salaries. Grants were issued to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and the Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery. Council opted out of the MHI Spring Weight Restriction Program for 2022 and set the date for the Budget Meeting.

Contributions to multiple programs and memberships for 2022 in several organizations were approved. Requests for proposals for the supply of diesel fuel and for 2022 gravel hauling and spreading were called. Advertising in local school yearbooks was approved. Council agreed to allocate the entire population of the R.M. to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2023 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Council also authorized a road improvement project for 2022.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
