3. VEHICLE CLASSIFICATION

3.1 VEHICLE DEFINITIONS

Type A Standard

A vehicle to standard specification as delivered by the manufacturer. For Vehicle preservation groups 2, 3 and 4, factory-approved modifications and typical accessories available on the market in the period are acceptable.

Type B Modified

A vehicle specially built or modified for specific purposes, typical of its kind, and thus of historic interest in its own right. Solely in relation to Vehicle preservation groups 1 - 5 the builder of such a vehicle is regarded as "maker".

Type C Reproduction

A vehicle built out of period, with or without period parts, imitating a design of the period. Such a vehicle must be clearly marked as to indicate that it is a reproduction. The builder of such a vehicle is considered as manufacturer in relation to Vehicle preservation groups 1-5. Such a vehicle may only be considered eligible if its date of manufacture falls within the age limits of the VCC. Before an issue of a VCC Vehicle I. D. Card the Registrar may invite the Management Committee to adjudicate or refer to the VCC Vehicle Technical Committee for a decision, or express the final decision as to whether a vehicle is acceptable to the VCC. Please refer to Appendix E of the Vehicle Technical Code for Period Special Group 1 & Group 2 regulations.

3.2 VEHICLE PRESERVATION GROUPS

Group 1 Authentic

One vehicle, as originally produced, unaltered and with little deterioration. Completely original, including interior and exterior finish: exceptions only for tyres, spark plugs, battery and other perishables.

Group 2 Original

One vehicle as used but never restored, to original specification with a continuous history, and to original possibly deteriorated condition. Parts that normally wear may be replaced with parts to period specification. Period replaced paint work, plating and upholstery permitted.

Group 3 Restored

One vehicle with known identity, wholly or partly dismantled, reconditioned and reassembled. Only minor deviations from maker's specification in the case of unavailability of parts or materials. Original manufacturer's parts should be used where available but may be replaced with others of the same specification. Interior and exterior finish as close as possible to period specification.

Group 4 Rebuilt

Parts from one or more vehicles of the same model or type assembled into one vehicle as close as possible to the maker's original specification. Parts may have to be manufactured in the process of rebuild or made outside period (such as body, engine block, cylinder head, or other nonidentity carrying parts). Interior and exterior finish as close as possible to period specification and must be visually correct.

Group 5 Constructed

Parts from one or more different vehicles assembled into a Vehicle representative of ONE period within the age limits of the VCC. Copy parts are acceptable if they are constructed from original materials and to a design, which is compatible with the period the vehicle purports to represent.

3.3 VEHICLE CATEGORIES

- A. Motor Vehicles constructed prior to December 31st 1918, such vehicles to be known as Veteran Vehicles. (VET)
- B. Motor Vehicles constructed between January 1st 1919 and December 31st 1931, such vehicles to be known as Vintage Vehicles. (VV)
- C. Motor Vehicles constructed between January 1st 1932 and December 31st 1945, such vehicles to be known as Post Vintage Vehicles. (PVV)
- D. Motor Vehicles constructed between 1st January 1946 and December 31st 1960, such vehicles to be known as Post War Vehicles. (PWV)
- E. Motor Vehicles constructed between 1st January 1961 and 31st December 1980, such vehicles to be known as Post 60 Vehicles (**P60V**)
- F. Motor Vehicles constructed after 1st January 1981 provided that no vehicle is accepted for this class until January 1st of the year that is thirty years after its original year of construction, such vehicles to be known as Post 1980 Vehicles. (**P80V**)
- G. Historic Racing Vehicles, which are at least in their thirtieth year since their year of original construction. (See Constitution, objects II, 1h). Plus Factory built racing cars no longer in production. (**HRV**)
- H. Period Specials (**PS1**) Group One is a vehicle which has been built up utilizing period production components within the periods represented in A, B, C, D &, E These Production Modified vehicles (**PM**) will be grouped as either B4 & B5.

Period Specials (**PS2**) Group Two is a vehicle which has been constructed with or without period parts to imitate a design of a particular period. This vehicle must be a very accurate imitation of an original vehicle. These Constructed vehicles will be grouped as either C4 & C5.
