**The Bible and "Charlie"...Summary...**

**Read the Bible.** It is Inspired (by God Himself), Inspiring (helps encourage us), and Inerrant (without error). So: study the Bible, be inspired by it and take time to *lectio divina*: meditatively ponder Bible passages—frequently!
