

The Prophecy of Jesus About The Establishment and Spread of the Pagano-Christian Church

Jesus name is Yeshua. Yeshua Jesus is the very person YHWH (God incarnate as human Jesus). YHWH is One. YHWH is not two or three or four. YHWH is Abba Father, is Ben Elohim the Son of God, and is haRuah haQodesh the Holy Spirit. One God.

Jesus prophesied of the false Church and of the false shepherds (pastors, missionaries, bishops, priests, ministers and leaders of the churches). His prophecy proved to be true and exact.

In order to study this topic and any other theological topic, we must refer and use the original text which is written by God-inspired Apostles and God-inspired Prophets.

If we use the English translations, or any other translation, we may err and we may come to strange though logical false conclusions.

For this reason, I am including both original texts which are preserved in the Aramaic Apostolic Writings in Babylon (where Peter lived and served YHWH) and the original Hebrew text which is referred to as "Shem Tov" manuscripts.

The text in English (Matthew 24:1-13):

1. And Yeshua Jesus went out of the temple to depart, and his disciples drew near and were showing him the construction of the temple. 2.

But he said to them, "Behold, don't you see all these things?

Truly I say to you, nothing will be spared. Not one stone here will be left upon another, which will not be torn down."

3. And while Yeshua Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives, his disciples drew near and were saying among themselves and to him, "Tell us when these things will be and what is the sign of your coming and the end of the world."

4. Yeshua Jesus answered and said to them, "Beware, let no man deceive you. 5. For many will come in my name and will say that 'I am the Mashiyach.' And many they will deceive.

6. For you are bound to hear of revolutions and rumor of wars. Watch out and do not be disturbed, for it is necessary that all these things happen, but it is not yet the end. 7. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines and plagues and earthquakes in different places. 8. But all these things are only the beginning of sorrows.

9. Then they will deliver to afflictions and they will kill you and you will be hated by all nations because of my name. 10. Then many will stumble and will hate one another and will betray one another. 11. And many false prophets will arise and deceive many. 12. And because of the growth of iniquity, the love of many will grow cold. 13. But whoever has patience until the end, he will have life.

The original text in Hebrew

The prophecy about the Pagano-Christian Church is found in two verses, Matthew 24:4-5 above.

Jesus said, take heed (be careful - be watchful - be on guard) because many people will come in the name of Jesus. This means that they are Christian pastors, missionaries, church leaders, ministers, bishops, popes, priests.

These people will claim that they are “the anointed by God”. The term “christ” means anointed.

In Aramaic and Hebrew the roots for the word “anoint” are “MaSHaH” “מִשַּׁח”.

The Greek translation of this word “MaShiaH” is “Christos” “χρῑστος”.

The word Christos comes from the Greek verb “Chriw” “χρῑω” which means “to anoint”.

Yeshua Jesus is the Anointed One by God to be the Messiah and the Lamb of God. He is also anointed by God to come again as the Messiah and the Lion of Judah.

YHWH’s act of redemption is two steps:

First, the Messiah freed the captives from the claim of Lucifer.

Second, the Messiah will destroy Lucifer and all those who follow him and they will be sent to the Lake of Fire.

Thus, it is easy to confuse the expression which uses the word “Christ or Christs.” False Christian teachers claim with enthusiasm and conviction that they are the anointed by God (Christs) which can be confused with the term Jesus Christ in these verses Matthew 24:4-5.

Now, let us read these two verses with this clarity:

“4. Yeshua Jesus answered and said to them, “Beware, let no man deceive you. 5. For many (most pastors and most Bible teachers) will come in my name (claiming that they are believers in Christ - Christians) and will say that ‘I am the Messiah (They will say that they are the anointed ones.) And many they will deceive.”

And, even if they say that Jesus is the Messiah, their teaching will deceive many, possibly 90% of the Christians.

Why do pastors, Bible teachers, ministers, missionaries, bishops, priests, popes ...etc. say that they are the anointed ones?

Without this false claim, they have no authority to lead and control the people of the church, and they have no justification to take the money of the people into their pockets while claiming that they are serving Jesus Christ.

People are literally scared of those who claim that they are the christs (the anointed ones). They truly believe that they must have the power of God. Some people deal with pastors as if they are God. Others are scared to offend any pastor who claims to be “anointed.” And, most people feel or think that giving a lot of money to the pastors pleases God. Some women, sadly, believe that having sex with pastors is a service to God, as the pagan did “holy prostitution to Apollo and Aphrodite.”

People ignore the teachings of Yeshua Jesus when He said that He will come and visit us as a poor, weak, imprisoned, isolated, helpless, child and faithful poor widows. Christians give generously to the false pastors and the false Bible teachers. Hence these pastors and Bible teachers live a very comfortable and opulent lifestyle and they enjoy almost absolute power over the people. Claiming that they are the anointed

(christs) by God is essential for them to keep their power and benefits.

Anyone who claims to be anointed by God will immediately receive attention, fear, money, and submission from the people who do not know the Word of God.

They come in the name of Jesus, but they may be not true believers. They claim that they are “the anointed by God” to preach the Gospel, yet their goal is power and money which they claim to be for their ministry, but in truth, most of this money is for their own pockets, salaries, personal lifestyle, and personal expenses.

Jesus said that these people will be very popular (seductive - worshiped - honored - beloved) and they will deceive many. It is possible that 90% of the Christians who attend Sunday worship and who give their hard earned money to the church or directly to these preachers are misled, deceived and are not truly born again.

This prophecy is serious and it is sad to see that it is actual for the past sixteen centuries.

If you are a true believer, then you need to stop accepting the deception and the confusion. Stop listening to any Bible teacher or pastor who is living off the money which belongs to God (belongs to the poor and the needy people).

If you are a true believer, then you need to step out of Babylon. Do not believe those who describe Babylon as a physical place, because Babylon is every place where faith is compromised, i.e., the Churches.

If you are a true believer, then move out from the organized **“Socio-Political-Pyramidal-Religious Organization”** which is the **Church** and begin meeting in house assemblies (ekklyssias) without

giving your money or worship to any leader. Your offerings should be given to the poor directly without intermediary, unless you are too busy or aloof to give Jesus his money, the tithe and the offerings. Your worship and obedience should be given to Jesus Christ only,

If you are a true believer, stop being a follower of popular or eloquent pastors. They are misleading possibly 90% of the Christians. You should have no Head, but Jesus Christ alone.

Most people feel the need to be led and to be told what to believe and what to do. This is a very dangerous and vulnerable place; no wonder psychotherapists, doctors, pastors are very rich and powerful.

Peter and Paul warned us about desiring the spiritual milk and refusing the solid pure spiritual food.

A baby must grow and develop by eating solid healthy and pure food.

1 Peter 2:2 "As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby."

1 Corinthians 3:2 "I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able."

A true believer follows one person only, Jesus Christ and no one else.

Now, let us examine all the thirteen verses in Matthew 24:1-13.

5. For many will come in my name and will say that 'I am the Mashiyach.' And many they will deceive.

There are several interpretations
Many people will come in My name, means they claim to be Christians and they claim to be ministers of God (pastors, teachers, missionaries ...etc.).

They will claim that they are the anointed by God. Without such false claim, they can have no power, or money from the people.

Notice, that magicians and Satanists make similar claims saying that they have special anointing from Lucifer or God and they have authority and powers.

They may affirm their faith that Jesus is the Messiah, but their messages otherwise are deception, compromise with the world, compromise with paganism, and confusion.

6. For you are bound to hear of revolutions and rumor of wars. Watch out and do not be disturbed, for it is necessary that all these things happen, but it is not yet the end. 7. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines and plagues and earthquakes in different places. 8. Jesus described certain necessary events in two time periods:

(A) BEGINNING WORLD EVENTS

- 1) Revolutions and wars.
- 2) Threats of wars.
- 3) Ethnic groups against each other (nation against nation).
- 4) Kingdom against kingdom.
- 5) Famine (lack of food and drinking water).
- 6) Plagues: true epidemics and false plagues such as COVID1-180.
- 7) Earthquakes throughout.

(B) FINAL EVENTS

- 8) Persecution of the faithful.
- 9) Martyrdom of the faithful.
- 10) Hatred of the faithful.
- 11) Rejection of the faith by false believers due to hardship.
- 12) False teachers cause deception and stumbling.
- 13) Christians will betray and deliver each other to persecution.
- 14) A large number of false prophets: preachers, pastors, missionaries and church leaders.
- 15) Increase of sin and iniquity.
- 16) Love is no longer love. Love becomes egocentrism, domination, sex, use, and abuse of others for benefits.
- 17) The true believers will remain faithful and will endure in patience waiting for eternal life.

Finally, someone may say, but Jesus established the Church as we read in Matthew 16:18 "And I (Yeshua Jesus) also say to you that you are Peter (Petros), and on this rock (petra) I will build My Church (ekklyssia), and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."

The reason for this confusion is the mistranslation of the word "My Church."

The original Aramaic, Hebrew and the Greek translation says: "My Congregation - My Ekklyssia" and not "My Church." This is a wrong translation in English.

Someone may say, but the ekklyssia is the church. The answer is NO, absolutely not.

The ekklyssia is the congregation of the truly born again believers. They have Jesus Christ as the only Head and they all are servant of one another. Furthermore, no one makes profit or takes salary or compensation from it.

The Church is Socio-Political-Pyramidal-Religious Organization. The Church is a business and the top of the pyramid receive salaries, compensations, expenses and have all the power over the people of the Church.

In conclusion, the Church is man-made. While the ekklyssia is YHWH God-made.

Jesus prophetied that the believers will move into a business like organization, the Church, where there will be false teaching and deception of the majority of people to keep them away from the pure faith.
