WHAT IS CHOICE?

"Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!" (Matthew 7:21-23)

VITAL QUESTIONS EACH INDIVIDUAL MUST ASK THEMSELVES

- Do I want to live a life on earth where I refuse to hear God and have God refuse to hear me?
- Do I want to be ashamed to own Jesus before men on earth and have Jesus not own me before the angels and God in eternity?
- Do I want to wear the sign of a person already accused, persecuted and sentenced to eternal death or Do I want to wear the seal of a person already acquitted, pardoned and signed up for eternal life?
- Do I want to spend eternity in the Heavenly Father's bosom or do I want to spend eternity in the hell flames burning?
- Do I want to spend eternity experiencing despair, hunger, thirst, pain and shedding tears or do I want to spend eternity experiencing deliverance, holiness, transformation, peace and sweet tranquility?
- Do I want to shout hallelujah and be seated proudly with the angels and saints in heavenly places or do I want to scream for help and suffer painfully with the demons and sinners in hell's pit?
