Event Information

The *Double C Farm 2021 Mountain Trail Challenge Series* will follow the rules, regulations and judging guidelines of the Premier Mount N Trail Association (PMT). A copy of the *PMT Standards, Guidelines, Rules and Regulations* is available on our website. *Please take time to familiarize yourself with these new regulations as they differ slightly from previous years.*

If you plan to compete for points toward the Double C Farm Mountain Trail Challenge Year End Awards, a *one time* fee of \$20, per division, must be paid prior to the first Challenge date. To qualify for Year End Awards, you must have competed in at least 3 out of the 4 Challenge dates. Scores from all 4 dates will be tabulated for Year End Awards. Champion and Reserve will be awarded for each DIVISION and 1st - 3rd place will be awarded for each CLASS for Year End.

Pre-registration, either electronic or paper copy, is required for each Challenge event. Full payment is required to reserve your spot. Email a current copy of your Coggins with your Liability Waiver/Release form to doublecfarmllc@yahoo.com. Photos of your paperwork will be accepted. Waivers can be found on the events page of the website: www.doublecfarm.net/events.

****All paperwork and fees MUST be received prior to each event.****

We will be keeping a log of all **2021 Coggins**. If your coggins will be **valid throughout the entire season, you need only submit it ONCE**.

Requests for cancellation may be submitted *up to* 10 days prior to the date of the event and are subject to a \$20 administration fee. No refunds will be given within 10 days of the event, though you have the option of transferring/selling your spot to another individual.

A description of the different DIVISIONS and LEVELS is available on the "Class List" sheet. Riders/Handlers may choose to enter 2 consecutive levels; in-hand, riding, or *both*.

For example: An Adult Division Rider/Handler may choose to enter Level 1 and Level 2 In-Hand and Riding for each Challenge date.

New for 2021... we are offering a **Green Horse** class. This class is open to *horses that have little to no formal training*. This class is open to ALL riders.

The Youth Division is specified as any rider 18 years of age and under (as of January 1). If enough Youth entries are received, we may divide this division into more defined age groups.

A Miniature Equine/Pony Division may be offered if there is enough interest.

Required attire:

Western handlers/riders should be dressed clean and neat in jeans with no tears. A long or short sleeve collared button up shirt or polo is acceptable. Adults may ride in a cowboy hat, helmet, ball cap or visor. Proper western riding boots are required.

English handlers/riders should be dressed clean and neat in breeches and a collared shirt with sleeves. Jackets are not required. Adults may ride in a helmet, visor, or ball cap. Proper English riding boots are required.

Helmets are required for any Youth competitor (in-hand and/or riding).

A limited number of stalls are available on-site and off-site. The off-site facility is approximately a 10 minute drive. Stalls are \$25/night with a one time \$20 stripping and sanitizing fee. Bedding is available, if needed, for \$7/bale and must be ordered in advance. You are responsible for all necessary care of your horse at either site. Please supply your own feed, hay, buckets and mucking supplies. Water will be available at both sites.

As always, please clean up around your vehicle/trailer before you leave for the day. This includes clearing any manure and loose hay. For your convenience, a manure disposal area will be available near the trailer parking area.

For their safety and the safety of our exhibitors, we ask that you please leave your dogs and/or other personal pets at home.
