
# Road Report

# Appraisal Update

Egenes and Bob Krueger met with Mike Roers of Lakes Area Appraisals and discussed that we needed a before (gravel) and after (Base One, Otta Seal and chip seal) appraisal on properties on Moe Hall and Tall Timbers. Mike Roers chose 3 on the lake and 3 off the lake unimproved lots and found comparable sales to determine what the increase in property would be with a hard surface road. Mike Roers summary report showed that property values would increase by \$4,600 to \$7,800. Bob Krueger suggested that we get a certified road engineer from the MN Department of Transportation to take a look at the road where the farms are to determine if this type of road would support that additional weight. Johnson added that the road will go up an additional 5.5 inches, 4 inches of gravel and 1.5 inches of Otta Seal.

Egenes will check with Bill Luethner to see if another petition would be required since the first one was denied.

The proposal is for a road 24 feet wide with a 22 foot hard surface.
