VADA-CH is extremely excited to welcome Micheal Bragdell, Head Trainer at Hilltop Farm, Colara, MD, for an Afton Stables clinic on April 26 – 27, 2023.

Michael is originally from Gothenburg, Sweden, and worked several years at a riding school, serving as an instructor and member of the show jumping team. He continued his education in England where he trained and showed young horses for Gustavii Stud. In 1995, Michael joined the Hilltop Team and, over the years, he has presented numerous stallions and countless mares and foals at breed registry inspections as well as at breed shows around the country. Michael believes in keeping the work interesting for the young horse to ensure they stay fresh and happy throughout their career. Seven of the youngsters that Michael has started at Hilltop have gone on to top finishes in the USEF/Markel Young/Developing Horse National Championships.

In 2008, Michael captured his first National Championship aboard Selten-HW in the FEI Four-Year-Old division and captured this championship again in 2012 with Hemmingway. In 2018 and 2019, Michael and SenSation HW won the USEF Young Horse National Championships. Michael has won seven US Dressage Finals National Championships as well and is a USDF Bronze, Silver, & Gold Medalist. Michael is a USDF Certified Instructor.

Terry coupled the sports world with her dance and music knowledge to help a variety of athletes in the total development of their freestyle performances. This led to the establishment of Klassic Kur in 1989.

Her commitment to freestyle education is extensive, writing scores of articles in print and online. Her lectures include the very first international judges freestyle symposium in 2002 and extend to the recent IDOC (International Dressage Officials) seminar held at USDF headquarters in Kentucky.

Her talent, service and dedication earned Terry the 2021 USDF Lifetime Achievement Award.


