## APPALACHIAN YOUTH CAMP & KIDZ ADVENTURE Rules and Packing List

## **Camp Rules:**

- Each church is asked to provide counselors for their youth, if possible. All dorms will be under adult supervision.
- NO ONE will be allowed to leave the campus without permission from the Head Men's or Women's Counselor.
- Couples will not be allowed to wander away from the groups to be alone on the campus.
- All Campers are required to submit to the authority of the AYC staff at all times, including coaches, dorm counselors, and security staff.
- Campers must participate in all activities of the camp.
- Campers must attend all services.
- Possession and/or use of alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- Campers may not possess any weapons during AYC or any LGL event. Possession of a weapon may result in immediate dismissal.
- Dress Code:

Realizing that there is an increasing trend toward immodesty of dress in public places, Live God Loud is determined to abide by Christian concepts of modesty as an expression of holiness at all times in public.

All constituents of Live God Loud ministries, both staff and students, are to dress with the Christian simplicity and modesty that become holiness (Proverbs 29:23; 1 Timothy 2:8-10; James 4:6; 1 Peter 3:3-4; 1 John 2:15-17).

- Shorts, Skirts, and Dresses should be a modest length and may not be shorter than the individual's finger tips.
  - √ (no short shorts or short skirts permitted)
- Shirts must have sleeves.
- Be mindful of shirt/top necklines so as not to draw the attention of others
- No tight fitting clothing
