Responsibilities and Duties

- Understand the issues impacting the transgender and gender diverse/ non-conforming community (examples: housing, lack of transportation, employment).
- Develop and maintain a knowledge base of social services available to transgender and gender diverse clients in the Charlotte Metropolitan area.
- Establish working relationships and partnerships with regional service providers to enhance the referral process and resources available.
- Conduct culturally competent psychosocial assessments of clients and create a holistic service plan in conjunction with the client and other organizations, when appropriate.
- Maintain documentation regarding attempts to access services and service delivery.
- Complete referrals to services, assist clients with intake requirements for these services, and follow up as necessary/able.
- On occasion, support special events regarding services to the public.
- Other duties assigned as needed by Executive Director.

Qualifications

- Masters degree in Social Work or related field preferred, Bachelors degree with related experience accepted.
- Experience working with diverse populations, including the economically disadvantaged and transgender/gender diverse/gender non-conforming individuals is preferred.
