



Remote learning report guide

As well as writing your parental statement for your child's EHCP, you may also wish to write an education report based on your findings whilst home educating your child while they were unable to attend school.

All other professionals who have an input in your child's learning will be asked to contribute to the assessment to help make up a clear picture of your child's needs.

You have valuable information to feedback on your child learning over the time they have not been attending school, so this should be included too.

If you wish to do a report, here are some bullet points to help you put together all the information you need.

- Child Name
- Your name
- Tutored for the period from: Date – Date
- Where resources came from: school /online/ parents.
- How you structured the day
- What goals if any you set
- Child's approach to learning
- How your child coped with home learning
- What they found achievable
- What they found hard
- How did you find their learning differed from when at school?
- Did you have to differentiate the work to suit your child?
- Did taking regular breaks help your child learn.
- What would have made it easier for your child?

This is only a guide of what you can possibly put in the report, just make sure you give them as much information as possible.
