The *Book of Discipline* and United Methodist congregations give the SPRC the responsibility for administering the relationship between staff, congregation, and the district superintendent so that the mission of the church moves forward. The SPRC also interviews and recommends any ministerial candidates to the charge conference.

Listening and responding to the church community (Pastor, staff and congregation) is a vital function of the SPRC. When conflict arises (different ideas in the same place and same time), good communication is important to strengthen the church. Anyone may approach committee members with concerns or deeply felt convictions to be brought to the attention of the committee. To assure the specifics are not misunderstood we ask that you also submit your concern by email or in writing.

Some of the SPRC responsibilities are:

Recommend staff positions to church council and accomplish needed hiring/termination. Develop job descriptions for staff and evaluate staff at least annually. Establish and review staff salaries in coordination with finance committee.

Be attentive and open to congregation opinions concerning staff, both positive and negative, and take appropriate action. (We don't know about differing opinions, conflicts or concerns if we aren't told)

Confer with the district superintendent about clergy leadership for the congregation

The committee meets as needed, at least quarterly, in closed session with all information shared in the committee (and in committee related emails) being confidential.

Open Position

The Song Leader position exists to lead congregational singing and to direct, support, and aid in choir and other choral performance. *Skills and Abilities Needed:* Ability to sight read music, Vocal skills to lead congregational singing, Knowledge of a variety of styles of worship music, Ability to motivate and inspire individuals, and Works well with a team.

Primary responsibilities: Support the congregation in worship, through music, for all regular and special worship services. Enhance worship through leading congregational singing, and directing choir, choral singing and special music.

Hours of Work: The workload for this position is approximately 7 to 10 hours per week, as established by the Music Director, primarily on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings.

General Help Needed

Sunday School classes and other groups, United Women of Faith, United Methodist Men, Sisters in Ministry, etc. are good about letting others in the group know when someone is ill or needs help. Often, Pastor Tom is not notified of such concerns. To improve communication, the SPRC is asking each class/ group to add Pastor Tom's email to your email group so he will be informed of needs for prayer, care, or visitation. Tom's email is tom.pierce@twkumc.org

To further help improve notification and communication, we ask that when you are at church, in addition to telling Tom about something, that you place a note in his mail box in the office. As Tom says, his head is full with the sermon, the bible study lesson, the funeral eulogy, etc. When someone or 3 people tell him something, it may be forgotten in the activities of the moment. A note in his mail box assures he is reminded.

Finance

Financial Audit

Recently the Committee on Audit and Review of General Council on Finance and Administration of the United Methodist Church published the booklet "Local Church Audit Guide". The 20 page booklet provides detailed instructions on the type of audit performed, who can perform the audit and recommended procedures to accomplish the audit.

For churches of our size with less than \$500 thousand in receipts, an independent qualified member of the church or other volunteer can perform audit procedures and evaluate internal controls and report the results directly to the church's finance committee.

As a result of these new guidelines the finance committee has switched from using an external auditor to doing an internal audit using the UMC guidelines. Debbie Goss, Cindy Burkitt, and Teri Towe are the members of the audit committee. Deb is a CPA, Cindy is an accountant and Teri has accounting experience.

As of December 2, 2022, of all items reviewed and reconciled, there is no evidence of misuse of funds.
