

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with two councillors absent.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 were approved as circulated, the minutes of the Budget Meeting held on March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019 were approved as presented, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of March were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized the removal of garbage from the ditches of PG601 by the U16 Southeast Hawks in return for a donation to assist with the team's expenses, set a special meeting April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 for conducting interviews for the Full Time Public Works Employee, approved the Auditor's Report and Audited Financial Statements for 2018, and adopted the 2019 Budget leaving the Uniform Mill Rate at 12.0 Mills. Council authorized payment of the voluntary levy to Sask. Crime Stoppers, authorized donations to the Alida & District Lion's Club and Act One for their assistance with the 2019 Ratepayer's Supper, authorized the contracting of Provincial Pothole & Paving for crack sealing on Primary Grid 601, authorized the purchase of two 2019 JD 870GP motor graders, and directed an Expression of Interest under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program to be completed.

Four delegations were received including ratepayers, a salesman, and a representative for the U16 Southeast Hawks.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved for wellsites, approach use, pipeline and powerline installations, and pipeline remediation.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
