Mass Readings for the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading – Sirach 15:15-20: "Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him."

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 119: "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!"

Second Reading – 1 Corinthians 2:6-10: "Rather, we speak God's wisdom, mysterious, hidden, which God predetermined before the ages for our glory, and which none of the rulers of this age knew; for, if they had known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory."





The readings for the 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time focus on the law and commandments. The first reading tells us to choose life by obeying God's commandments. The second reading reminds us that God's wisdom is far greater than our own. And in the gospel Jesus tells us he has come to fulfill the law, not to abolish it.



The traditional numbering and order of the ten commandments is as stated in the Catechism of the Catholic Church [n. 2051] with references to Scripture added.

1. I am the LORD your God: you shall not have strange gods before me.

(Exodus 20:2-6; Deuteronomy 5:6-10)

2. You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain. (Exodus 20:7; Deuteronomy 5:11)

3. Remember to keep holy the LORD'S Day.

(Exodus 20:8-11; Deuteronomy 5:12-15)

4. Honor your father and your mother.

(Exodus 20:12; Deuteronomy 5:16)

5. You shall not kill.

(Exodus 20:13; Deuteronomy 5:17)

6. You shall not commit adultery.

(Exodus 20:14; Deuteronomy 5:18)

7. You shall not steal.

(Exodus 20:15; Deuteronomy 5:19)

8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. (Exodus 20:16; Deuteronomy 5:20)

9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.

(Exodus 20:17; Deuteronomy 5:21)

10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

(Exodus 20:17; Deuteronomy 5:21)



In 1233, seven Florentine laymen—two married, two widowed, three single—all well-known merchants and members of a Marian confraternity, abandoned homes, jobs, and wealth for a life of poverty, prayer, and penance at Monte Senario, where they built a chapel and hermitage. Within a few years, they formed the Order of Friar Servants of Mary, or Servites, a mendicant order that received formal papal approval in 1304. The seven founders, jointly canonized in 1888, are: Bonfilius, Bonajuncta, Amadeus, Hugh, Manettus, Sostene, and Alexis. Alexis, who out of modesty refused ordination, served the order in various ways as a lay brother; he outlived the other founders and reportedly died at age 110.
