A Counter-Attack Against All Enemies of the Bride of Christ

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The fact is we had just completed a 30-day fasting assignment last June for the Black Race, and frankly none of us was anticipating another warfare assignment, at least not this soon. Around mid-June, and during the Black Race fasting period, we were being led by the Holy Spirit to do some intense research on the history and the future of Christ's Church. It was then that we started coming across some amazing facts that we needed to share on both the USA & the Haiti lines, and which lasted four weeks in an eight-part series titled "Unveiling the Counterfeit Church".

Through our research, we got a better understanding of why satan will stop at nothing, even to see the whole world cast into hell, to undermine God's plans and deceive the world into worshipping him at all levels. His pride and envy have caused him to mimic everything that God does in order to deceive the Church into believing it's the "real thing." Through

that extended research, we broke the code of several passages, especially in the books of Daniel and Revelation. We also discovered that, in most instances, the prophecies in both books complement each other in so many ways. We came to better understand what many chapters in Revelation were portraying, especially for the end times.

In chapter 1, Christ was dead and now is alive. In chapter 2, Jesus won the victory over the church that satan took over. In chapter 3, we see Jesus talking to the Laodicean church, while still inside His Church. But overtime, He got kicked out of the church on earth and is found outside, knocking and asking to be let inside. But in chapters 3 and 4, a door that no one on earth could close is open in heaven for Jesus to come in. In the beginning of chapter 6, God triumphed one more time and satan tried to use the seven seals to bring confusion and chaos on the earth, but we see that God triumphed one more time. Because in verses 9-10. we see the people that satan was using to bring confusion on the earth lost and went into hiding, asking the mountains to fall on them. In chapters 7 to 10, the seven seals are open, and there is trouble on earth. Chapter 11, the Temple is open, and the Ark of the Covenant could be seen in heaven. Chapter 12 shows a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon beneath her feet, and a crown of twelve stars on her head. She was pregnant, and she cried out because of her labor pains and the agony of giving birth which represents the birth of Christ which is also the birth of the Church, because Christ was to ransom the Church by His blood.

We revisited the prophecy of the four beasts:

- 1) the Lion
- 2) the Bear
- 3) the Leopard
- 4) fourth beast not specifically identified and was different from first three beasts.

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As satan always wants to compete with God in everything, we also discovered that satan has a trinity, which of course is a luciferin trinity, a diabolical trinity. Here is the parallel as shown in the Bible:

1) God the <u>Father</u> in Heaven versus the red dragon (satan) coming from heaven:

a) According to Ps 48:2, the Father in heaven has a throne on Mount Zion, in the far north. The red dragon resides in the second heaven and also has a throne. Isa 14:13 says - "For you said to yourself, I will ascend to heaven and set my throne above God's stars. I will preside on the mountain of the gods far away in the north."

2) Jesus the <u>Son</u> of God versus the beast coming from the sea:

- a) When Jesus was about to start His ministry on earth, the first thing He did was to be baptized in the Jordan River. So His ministry started after He got out of the water. The beast coming from the sea (a body of water) is mimicking the Lord coming out of the Jordan. Rev 13:1 talks about the beast who stood on the shore of the sea. "And I saw a beast coming out of the sea. It had ten horns and seven heads, with ten crowns on its horns, and on each head a blasphemous name." This is where he started his diabolical ministry, in water (the sea).
- b) Jesus resembles His Father. He said, if you see me, you also see the Father because the Father and I are one. Now, the beast from the sea (the son) looks like the red dragon (the father) who came from heaven. So that beast and the red dragon of the diabolical trinity both represent God, the Father and Jesus, the Son.
- c) Jesus has been crowned King of kings and Lord of lords. When He rose from the dead, He said "all power is given unto Me in heaven and on earth." Jesus received His power from His Father in heaven. The dragon coming from heaven gave the beast (coming from the sea) his power and his throne with great authority.
- d) We remember that Christ was fatally wounded but came back from the dead and He

received His power after His resurrection. We read in Rev 13:3 "One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound, but the fatal wound had been healed. The whole world was filled with wonder and followed the beast. People worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast, and they also worshiped the beast and asked, "Who is like the beast? Who can wage war against it?" When did he receive that power? Like Jesus, the beast received his power AFTER he was fatally wounded and he got healed, again mimicking Jesus who was dead and rose again. But how did the beast receive his wounds?

In 1798, the papal system was victimized when France invaded Italy and killed Pope Pie VI. While the papacy was still in existence, the office lost its global power. But, in February 1929, the papacy was restored by Benito Mussolini and Cardinal Secretary Pietro Gasparri and Pope Pius XII later. Since then, the papal system became very powerful. This is where the characteristics of the Son of God are found and that's also when the papacy gained all its universal power. Leaders of nations bow to him.

e) Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Phil 2:7-9) Pope Francis represents himself as Jesus. He is humble and resists being served, refusing to have a driver, refusing to sit on that throne that other popes sat on. He is very close to the people, as Jesus used to do it. He is a man that the whole world listens to because the whole world is in admiration of him.

f) Jesus came on the earth in the year AD'00 and died in the year AD'33 (around March/April) so His ministry lasted a total of 3½ years. In Rev 13:5, we read "Then the beast was allowed to speak great blasphemies against God. And he was given authority to do whatever he wanted for forty-two months or 3½ years."

3) The <u>Holy Spirit</u> versus the beast Coming out of the Earth:

a) The Holy Spirit's mission on the earth is NOT to work for Himself, but to lead us to worship the Father through Jesus. When we worship Jesus, we worship the Father. "Then I saw another [third] beast come up out of the earth. He had two horns like those of a lamb, but he spoke with the voice of a dragon. He exercised all the authority of the first beast. And he required all the earth and its people to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound had been healed." (Rev 13:11-13) Note that this third beast resembled a lamb, but it was a dragon. The mission of this third beast is to cause people to worship the second beast that came from the sea. When you worship the second beast, you also worship the red dragon or satan. This beast, in the diabolical trinity, is a representation of the Holy Spirit. "He did astounding miracles, even making fire flash down to earth from the sky while everyone was watching." (Rev 13:13) The first time we saw fire coming from heaven was on the day of Pentecost for the baptism of the Holy Spirit. But according to Rev 13:13, satan will bring fire from heaven to confuse people causing them to think that they're worshipping the true God when in reality, we're worshiping the dragon. Many will fall for his lies, and even some of the saints of God, if we're not careful.

Remember, the papal system (second beast) had died in 1798, and the only government that came on the earth around the same time of the fall of the papacy is the United States - born on July 4, 1776 with humble beginnings. They were a protestant nation, they were humble like a lamb, doing good on the earth, teaching the word of God in the schools and running the

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government with great Christian values. After WWII, America became a very powerful nation on the earth, having allies with most developed nations. But with the rising of Donald J. Trump, things have changed. Thus, the U.S. started as a lamb, but over the course of time, they will talk like a dragon. As known to everyone, America has used its power to dominate the world, even started several wars at the cost of several lost lives and the destruction of nations. But now we see America losing her influence around the world. So the third beast also represents the United States. Thus, America is now set to give the papal system the power that it needs to govern the world and bring in the new world order -- one world government, one world currency and one world religion.

When one compares America with Rome, the resemblance between the two nations is just overwhelming, including the architectural structures of Washington, DC and the Vatican, their eagle symbol, their Statue of Liberty, etc. America and the Vatican will be the last systems on earth before the return of Christ. Also, prophecies showed that Pope Francis will be the last Pope, as events will continue to map the way for his rise to global power. As the year 2020 rolled in, we started seeing the beginning of tragedies and the vulnerability of both Italy and America to covid-19. But in reality, the world is changing and the stage is being set to make room for what must take place before Christ returns.

4) The Holy Church of Christ versus the Roman Catholic Church (RCC):

Like ancient Rome, today's Rome, via the Vatican, still has great influence over the world governments. History shows that May 14th is a very important date in the RCC. In our research, it was also confirmed that many events in the RCC occurred on that very specific date. For instance, you might recall, that Pope Francis had plans to commemorate the politic of Pope Gregory XIII this year, on May 14, 2020 under the cover of global education. But that plan got thwarted due to

covid-19. He was planning to meet with the political, religious and cultural leaders of the world to reinforce a global education program, signing a pact or a covenant with the religious leaders of the world, in order to return the whole world under the observance of the Sunday's rest to benefit the planet from global warming. March 7, 321, that Roman Emperor Constantine issued a civil decree making Sunday a day of rest from labor instead of the Levitical Saturday sabbath. Many other biblical principles have either been altered or completely eliminated by the RCC. The Hebrew calendar was changed to the Gregorian calendar which was introduced in October 1582 under Pope Gregory XIII. A number of Catholic holidays and myths, such as Christmas, Easter, and Mardi Gras, Halloween, All Saints' Day, are on the timeline of pre-Christian calendars with their pagan roots. Let's not forget that the RCC is the nest of paganism and also the root cause of Islam. The Catholic practice of praying to saints has been called "de-facto idolatry" and even a relic of goddess worship, including Mary, which is a representation of Europa or Isis / Ishtar.

There is no doubt that America is going down at a very fast pace, making room for the papacy to take charge which will be a global government. The Book of Revelation gives us a very clear picture as to what the end will look like as satan continues to masquerade himself under the covering of the RCC to resemble more and more like the true Church of Jesus Christ. So Church, beware!

That very elaborated eight-part series lasted a total of four weeks on both lines (USA-Haiti). During that time, we knew there would be a period of prayer and fasting that would follow. Spiritual Heart Attack - By Sister Fiona Watson

Heart attacks are one of the leading causes of deaths in the world. It is called, "the silent killer", because it develops slowly and silently over a period of time, with men being at greater risk than women. The heart is the center of all the operations of the human life. Every organ in the body relies on it. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength." (Deut. 6:5)

Physical Heart: the physical heart is defined as the organ in your chest that controls the flow of the blood around the body. However, there is also a spiritual heart that determines our lives' outcome.

Spiritual Heart: Hebrew לב רוחנ lebab/ leb [b'bel the inner part of a person. It refers to our will, mind, consciousness, emotions and understanding. It also refers to our moral character and determination. Life flows from the physical and spiritual heart.

A large part of the world's population was born with a physically healthy heart. However, there are a number of things that can contribute to an unhealthy heart. A diet that consists of foods that are rich, processed, sugar-coated, GMOs (genetically modified organisms), high in sodium and fat is a gateway to high blood pressure, diabetes, high cholesterol and obesity, to name a few. Any one or a combination of any of these issues can interrupt the rhythm of the heart, leading to a cardiac arrest, also known as heart attack. In other words, an unhealthy

diet is a contributing factor to heart attacks. Doctors recommend a diet high in fiber; low in fat, low in sugar and sodium, also, the consumption of plenty of water, exercise and adequate rest, to maintain the function of a healthy heart.

As unbelievers, our hearts were sick and had little or no appetite for the "healthy" things of God. Instead, our hearts hungered and craved for the wrong things such as porn, gossip, foul language, lying, etc., which were our main staple. Therefore, we came to Christ with defective hearts of all different shapes and sizes. Some came with unwilling hearts, some broken hearts, some offended hearts and others with unforgiving hearts. It would have been very difficult to prevent what flows out of our hearts. When we were 'born again' God gave us a 'new heart' (heart transplant) and a new spirit.

A heart transplant gives someone with a damaged heart another shot at life. A heart transplant patient would have been given strict lifestyle changes and instructions by their surgeon for the maintenance of that new heart. For example, a healthy diet, a good exercise plan with follow-up visits would make that list. Because, going back to the old habits could seriously jeopardize that new heart. The same way the transplant patient has to care for his new heart, we too must care for our 'new heart.' Since, both the spiritual heart and the physical heart must be maintained with a balanced diet. Our Master

Surgeon gave us instructions to care for our new heart as well. "Keep thy heart with all diligence, for out of it are the issues of life." Proverbs 4:23 "Issues of life" are common things, problems that occurred in our lives. "Let not your heart be troubled..." (John 14:1)

A consistent healthy diet on the 'Bread of Life' and the 'Living Water' will maintain our hearts. Exercising the Word strengthens the muscles of the heart. Reading and meditating on the Word of God also helps to maintain our hearts. The joy of it all is, we can never overeat the 'Bread of Life' or ever be afraid of drinking too much from the 'Living Water'. It's our refusal to eat or drink of Him, that would pose a threat to our hearts.

Both the physical and the spiritual heart patient will have struggles with their 'new heart':

- 1) The body might reject the new heart at first and that new heart will need to be acclimatized to the new body.
- 2) The desires of the old heart don't just go away. We will be tempted to revert. It will take practice and discipline to fight this battle. If temptation has its way and our diet starts to lack the necessary nutrients, our spiritual hearts will become defective. As a result, spiritual diabetes, cholesterol or high blood pressure could become major issues in our lives, causing us to experience a spiritual heart attack.

I was willing to yield to His will, but asked my Lord not to take me home without having seen all my children, grandchildren and great grandchild Matthias again, also my adopted son Sira in Uganda. Goodness is not about doing elaborate things to gain recognition. Oftentimes, it **is** the small acts of kindness we do throughout our day that mean the most to those around us. God's goodness and favor towards me isn't

based on my performance it's based on what Jesus already did for me. If you want to see God for who He really is, here's a good starting point. "Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good." (Ps. 136:1) "Taste and see that the Lord is good." (Ps. 34:8) "Enter His gates with thanksgiving, and His courts with praise! Give thanks to Him and praise His name! For the Lord is good and His love is eternal, and His faithfulness endures to all generations." (Ps. 100:4-5)

The Goodness of the Lord Through a 40-Day Fast

Fasting at my church is somewhat different from what most know it to be, and it is usually for a much shorter period of time. During a fast, we usually come together to sing praises to God, read the Bible and pray on different subjects all day. But after 6:00pm, we can have soup with no meat, bread, tea or water. Besides that, no one around me had ever fasted for an extended period of time, neither had I met anyone who even talked about fasting for 40 days until I was introduced to it through ETPIM Global. Still, the desire to do it burned in my heart. I just couldn't shake the feeling that if only I could complete a 40-day fast, something powerful would happen in my life! And it did! Among many other results of the fast, I am more focused, less tired, unless I overdo it as I often tend to do.

Delighting in the Word... - by Deaconess Marcia Thomas

Aspects of Meditating on the Word of God:

In the Bible, we see that God wants us to "meditate" on His Word. In the book of Joshua, we see where God commanded Joshua to not let the Book of the Law depart from his mouth, but to meditate on it day and night in order to observe and do all that is written in it. Then God promised to make his way prosperous and give him good success. (Josh 1:8) Thus, we must meditate on God's Word day and night to have success in this life. Note that the specific command is to "meditate day and night" not just day OR night.

Sometimes, I tend to meditate on the Word mostly early in the morning, but at night I am too tired to do so as I should. Thank God, I have an evening devotional that I go over just before going to sleep, nevertheless, in these present times, we all need to be more diligent at meditating on the Word of God day and night. The benefits of meditating on God's Word can be found, for example, in Psa 1:1-3: "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither, and whatever he does shall prosper."

- 1) We want to be like that tree that produces fruit all season long and prospers in all that the Lord has for us.
- 2) We can also "reflect" on the Word of God. We see an example of that in 2 Tim 2:7, where Paul advises Timothy to consider what he was told regarding being able to

endure hardship like a good soldier of Jesus Christ and to not get entangled in the affairs of this life (vv3-4).

- 3) With the global crises that we are all currently facing, we find that there are also many distractions. Thus, we too must endure hardship as soldiers of the Lord. This is done often by reflecting on the things that we have been taught in the Word of God. We can also look with "intent" into the Word of God. This involves paying great attention to it. Not much can be gained when we are idle with our time and then pick up God's Word as a second thought. If we expect to get all that the Word has for us, we/I must give it first place. We/I must be intentional with it (see James 1:25.)
- 4) Another aspect of meditating on the Word of God, is to "dwell" in it. We find in Col 3:16 (NKJV): "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." In Strong's 1774, the Greek meaning for "dwell" is to be settled (stationary) in; met: To be indwelling. From 'en' and liked; to inhabit.
- 5) To "ponder" is another aspect of meditating on the Word of God. In Psa 119:95, we find that while the wicked are waiting to destroy us, we can make a decision to ponder on the statutes of the Lord. This will not only keep us in faith but also will even deliver us from the hand of the enemy when we speak it forth with boldness.
- 6) Another aspect of meditating the Word of God is to "consider" it. In Exodus

- 33:13 (KJV) Moses pleads with the Lord, saying: "Now therefore, I pray Thee, if I have found grace in Thy sight, shew me now Thy way, that I may know Thee, that I may find grace in Thy sight: and consider that this nation is Thy people." We too can plead with the Lord the way Moses did, so we can know Him and know His ways better. Then we will know that He has our loved ones in His heart as we consider His Word, His love letter to us.
- 7) We can "eat" the Word of God. This is yet another aspect of meditating on the Word. Jeremiah 15:16 (NKJV) reads "Your words were found, and I ate them, and Your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart;" We also eat the Word of God especially when we receive a timely Rhema (spoken) word. It enlightens our heart and brings us much joy. Finally, we read in Rev 10:9-11 (NKJV), "So I went to the angel and said to him, 'Give me the little book.' And he said to me, 'Take and eat it; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth.' Then I took the little book out of the angel's hand and ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth. But when I had eaten it, my stomach became bitter. And he said to me, 'You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, tongues, and kings." We likewise need to eat this Book, the Word of God and share it with this dying world.

Help us Lord not to be ashamed of the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation to everyone who hears and heeds its message." Rom 10:9-

I pray that, as we truly consider these aspects of meditating on the Word of God, we would be found actually delighting In His Word! I pray this all in Jesus Mighty Name. Amen. Amen. Amen.
