





Subject: Yes for Peace – Bayanihan Para sa KKK (Kapayapaan, Kaunlaran at Kasaganaan) and Reiteration of Declaration of all Schools a ZONE of PEACE.

Date: February 3, 2016

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has sustained its commitment and active participation in the Yes for Peace in all public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide. Millions of responses were generated to the continuing peace education and advocacy campaign.
2. This campaign aims to encourage at least 10 Million peace-loving Filipinos, 10 years and older to speak as one to provide a democratic people's mandate for the comprehensive peace process particularly the cessation of hostilities between the government and all rebel groups.
3. To inculcate the Bayanihan Spirit and ensure that the target Ten (10) Million responses is attained from the Primary Target Audience, officers of Supreme Pupil Government (SPGs) and Supreme Student Government (SSGs) in public and private elementary and secondary schools are encouraged to undertake the activities listed in the enclosure under the guidance of the Araling Panlipunan (AP), Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (EP) and under the supervision of the school head.
4. The following materials are enclosed for reference: (a) Enclosure No. 1 – Master copies of Yes for Peace, Enclosure No. 2 – School Summary and Enclosure No. 3 – Schools District Summary.
5. Responses shall be consolidated per school and district. District consolidation be submitted to SDO on or before February 22, 2016.
6. In addition, a display of banner indicating "This School is a Zone of Peace" to remind all concerned to consider public schools as neutral grounds of peace zones and must not be used as battlegrounds or as targets of violence.
