You must submit the following with your application:

1. **If the person who provides your eligibility is alive**, they must be a member of The American Legion, eligibility documentation is likely not necessary; however you do need to provide his or her American Legion member ID number and Post information on your application. If they are not currently a member, please speak to someone to find out how they can become a member.
2. **If the person who provides your eligibility is deceased**, acceptable eligibility documents include:
 - a. DD-214 Discharge Papers (not issued until after the Korean War)
 - b. Official Military Orders
 - c. Official Military Service Citations/Awards
 - d. Letters related to the veteran's military service. Must be on official government letterhead
 - e. Certificate from the VA records center in St. Louis
 - f. Data from the back of older discharges
3. **If you are a female veteran**, and fall within the eligibility dates of the American Legion, you can also be a member of the Auxiliary. Your husband is also eligible to become an Auxiliary member as well.
