as having a headstone at one point and it cannot be found today. They owned the farm that the cemetery is on. It was important to document that they are buried there and this book corroborates it. The other finding that we found of interest was that of George Nelson Bowling. He died in 1935 and his obituary stated that he was buried in Tucker Cemetery. Our understanding is that burials were not taking place in the 1930's so when this book listed his headstone we found the person, whom we believe to be the last person to be buried in Tucker Cemetery. Because he currently doesn't have a headstone, he is not listed on the chart above, but we know that he is there, most probably next to his wife, Annie.

⁴⁾ Several headstones are used for two people and that is why you see the duplicate numbers used above. I can only use one number on the chart above, to plot the location of the headstone. 5) There is a series of books in the Library of Michigan called: Grave Undertakings: Thumb Cemetery Readings. These books list several times that groups have gone into the various cemeteries and wrote up their findings. What is important here is that they took headstone readings from the 1930's through the 1950's when you could still read these headstones or if the stone(s) are missing today, at least you knew that there used to be one. This is the case with missing headstones for John Tucker and his wife Sarah Tucker. They are on the list
