# Portrait class



The Danville Art League will sponsor a portrait class on Saturday, April 2nd, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., with a pot luck for lunch. **Kolleen Asaad** will be the instructor. The photo above is an example of one of Kolleen's pastel portraits. Participants will be creating their own portrait using a photo of their own.

The medium will be pastel, with materials provided by the Art League. Participants will be using premium paper for their portraits. Pastel is one of the only mediums that will work for a one day class, but participants can use the information learned to do a portrait in another medium.

Participants will need a photo that they have taken of the subject (person or pet). Also, an 8 x 10 (or larger) print of the photo is very helpful. Kolleen puts hers on cardboard. The pastel sets used will be available for purchase at the end of the day, if so desired.

Incidentally, some people prefer to wear masks so that they don't breathe in pastel dust. The class will be limited to 12 participants, and the cost is \$55.

#### Kickapoo Karvers at the Art League

The carvers meet the third Saturday each month from 9 a.m. to 12 noon. Our plans are to have a carving project every month that will involve different skills. We are also prepared to give demonstrations. We would like to invite all members of the Art League to join us.

If you are interested in learning how to carve, we have tools we can loan at the meeting. Due to insurance requirements, this is open to anyone over the age of 18. If under 18, a parent or legal guardian will need to accompany that person.

Starting at our March meeting, we are going to start a monthly carving competition we call "The Barking Dog Challenge." This challenge involves a barking dog carving involved in a progression of carved settings. April. The first carving is a setting of a barking dog with a single person, man or woman. The second setting is a barking dog with an inanimate object (toy or ball). Extra credit for imagination! The third setting is a barking dog facing a fence or hedge barking at something on the other side. The fourth setting is a dog with a man and a woman. The fifth setting is the barking dog with at least one additional dog.

There will be a judging of the carvings entered and the winner will receive \$25.00 each month. At the end of the competition there will be a judging of the group of carvings and the winner will receive \$100.00.

Carving blanks will be provided to art league members new to carving. Carvers will need to make their own blanks.

### Vermilion County Museum Exhibit



"The Auschwitz Experience in the Art of Prisoners" exhibit is comprised of 24 panels depicting the artwork of twelve survivors of the Auschwitz-Birkenau Camp

The 24-panel exhibit showcases 60 pieces that depict the experiences the survivors had during the Holocaust. This showing is the US premiere of the exhibit.

The exhibition's grand opening is Sunday, March 6 at the Vermilion County Museum, located at 116 N. Gilbert Street, Danville. The grand opening will take place from 1:30 to 5:00 p.m.

A special opening presentation from 3 to 3:30 p.m. will cover the history of Auschwitz. Music, light refreshments and tours of the exhibit.

Tours are available Tuesday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The exhibit closes on March 31.

Children's Art Programs will be held Saturday, March 19, 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. Grades 5-8 (25 in session). Children will be making a 4x4 expression tile after learning about the exhibit. Reservations required through the Museum. There is no charge.

The exhibit is a unique opportunity to educate people about the Holocaust through art created by Holocaust survivors.
