Summary:

This bill proposes that the national voting age be changed from 18 to 17 years of age. There are currently citizens who are under the age of 18, who are either contributing citiziens or members of government, who wish to participate in the presidential and midterm elections. They are unable to do so, due to the current age. Furthermore, the bill of rights is not clear on the age of 18 or 17, in the matter in which it is written.

Proposal:

Change the national voting age from 18 to 17 years of age. Clarify the voting age in the Draculian bill of rights.
