Tall Timbers & Moe Hall Road Feasibility Petition Update

Pioneer Park would give us a long term lease with the township being responsible for maintenance and insurance of the facility. They would want it to still be available for rent so Egenes will follow up with Minnesota Association of Townships Insurance Trust to see if that would present any liability issues.

Vosen Turn Around Update

Johnson worked with Jerry Vosen to obtain an auto renewing turnaround agreement for the end of Mosquito Lane.
