Before and After Care: 6:45-8:00am & 5:00-6:00pm, Drop-In Care

To gain access to the hours of 6:45-8:00am, as well as 5:00-6:00pm, enroll in before and after care for an additional \$6/per day (per child). Before and after care must be arranged, in advance, and with enrollment selections submitted, and approved, prior to the start of the week. Drop in before and after care is in additional \$35 per day. Drop-in/Add-on Full Days are \$85 each, due the day drop in care is received. Drop in care spots are based on availability, and openings are not guaranteed.

What does tuition include and how is tuition structured?

Tuition includes educational HighScope curriculum, additional social and emotional curriculum, developmental assessment tools, American Sign Language and French classes, music class, and morning snack/nutritious lunch. All closures, vacations, etc are built into the weekly tuition rate- no credit is given outside of the weekly rate for absences or closures. Tuition is based on reserving your child's spot, and not actual hours of attendance.

Tuition is due, in advance, every Monday morning. Late payment fees will be applied if weekly tuition is not paid by 6pm on Monday evening. Late payment fees start at \$25, as outlined in the Family Handbook

Supplies included: SSLC supplies sippy cups/drinking cups, wet wipes, all curriculum materials, foods listed on the menu (or planned substitutes), nap sheets/blankets/sleep sacks, and whole cow's milk for ages 12-24 months or low-fat cow's milk for ages 2 and up.

Families supply: one full set of extra clothes that are well fitting and weather appropriate (3 full sets for infants), weather appropriate outdoor gear, pacifier for ages 18 months and under (if used), diapers/pullups- only pullups or diapers with sides that open and close without tearing the diaper NO EASY-UPS, water bottle for ages 2 and up, infant bottles/purees along with breastmilk/formula, family preference/allergen safe food items when applicable, backpack large enough to fit a full sized folder and personal belongings.

What not to bring: Pull-ups/diapers that are not resealable, glass meal/drink items (including bottles), any item containing nuts, and toys/personal items from home except for one small lovey and blanket (not required) to be stored in the child's backpack.
