THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Today we celebrate the fact that Jesus, God's own Son, has come into our world as one of us. He has associated himself with sinners and been baptised at the hands of one of his own creatures. The baptism performed by John the Baptist was not the Sacrament of Baptism. It was a ceremony by which people publicly expressed sorrow for their sins and a desire for God's forgiveness. Jesus has no need of such a ceremony but he joins the queue of sinners, associating himself with sinful humanity and humbly seeks baptism from John.

In his account of Jesus' baptism, St. Mark's main concern is with Jesus' identity. The heavenly voice, 'You are my beloved Son' echoes Psalm 2:7, a psalm used for the coronation of the kings from the house of David, and thus points to Jesus as the Messiah. The words 'with you I am well pleased,' echo Isaiah 42:1, pointing to Jesus as the Isaian Servant who is to bear the infirmities of many. Thus Mark reveals Jesus as the royal Messiah and Suffering Servant.

Temporary suspension of Mass with congregation in attendance

Following the News this week that cases of COVID-19 are increasing at an alarming rate, on a daily basis, in our area – up from just 57 cases per 100,000 of the population in mid-December to approx 700 per 100,000 this week- We believe it is time we take the necessary steps to protect all members of our community. We are hearing of the difficulties which Hospital and ambulance Services are experiencing and the need to protect the NHS and Medical Staff.

On the advice of many parishioners, some of whom have continued to attend Mass in our Churches, we have decided **that both St. Patrick's and Our Lady of Lourdes Church will be CLOSED for regular PUBLIC MASSES, with IMMEDIATE EFFECT,** until further notice. Masses will continue to be **LIVE-STREAMED** until it is deemed safe to have our congregations return.
