Church adopted the following policy

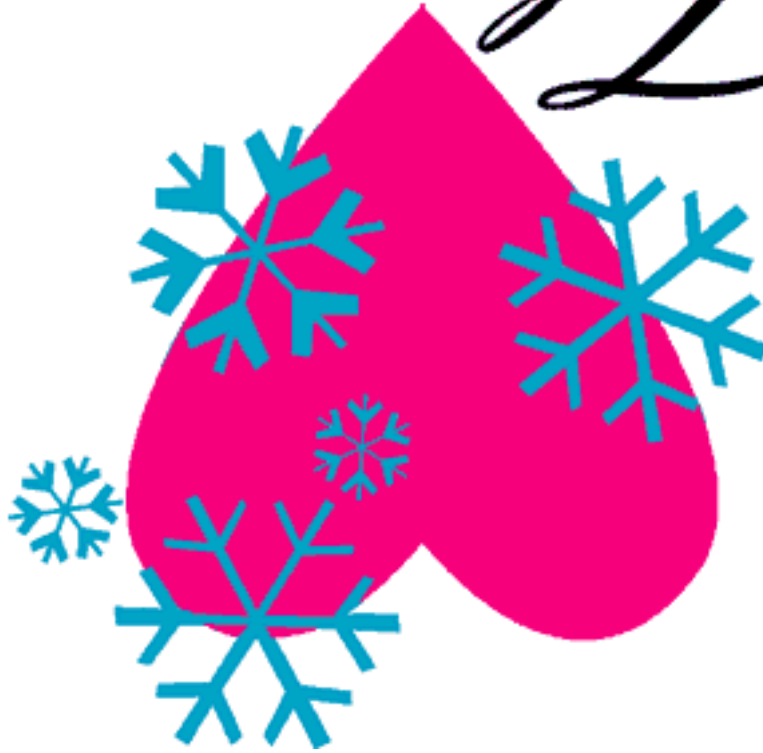
Motion made and passed to cancel services only if declared level 2 or 1 emergency by the county.
