### Bible Eyewitness and Bible Word Picture

TWO Separate Games to Play as a Group

#### Object of the game Bible Eyewitness:

A memory challenge to test yourself in paying attention to detail

### Object of the game Bible Word Picture:

Playing together as a group to think of something in the Bible that relates to your picture

#### Needed for the games:

- Print out the pictures below and if you would like, color them. Then cut them out. You can laminate them to last longer.
- A timer
- Pen/pencils and paper for each player

#### How to play Game #1 - Bible Eyewitness:

- 1. Someone who is not playing the game will need to choose 20 25 of the picture items and arrange them on a flat movable surface (a large tray or piece of cardboard). Be sure to do this in a separate room where no one else is looking.
- 2. When ready, bring the items out and place them in the middle of the room for everyone to see.
- 3. Time the players to observe the items for 1 minute.
- 4. When 1 minute is finished, remove or cover the items with a cloth.
- 5. Now, give the players 5 minutes on the timer to write down as many of the items as they can remember.
- 6. After 5 minutes, remove the covering or bring the items back in the room and let everyone see how much they remembered.
- 7. You can repeat the game using different picture items as many times as you would like.

#### How to play Game #2 - Bible Word Picture:

Place all the picture items in a bag and have each player draw one and say something that relates to the object they drew from the bag. Such as a Bible verse pertaining to the word picture or something they remember about the word. Help each other think of something. Hold on to the items and return them when you have finished the game.
