Coaches must meet the following prerequisites

Coaches must be at least 18 years of age

Participation in the sport at A or B grade playing level and/or A or B Grade umpire for at least 2 seasons in Australia or close involvement in the sport for four seasons

Successful completion of Australian Coaching and Officiating Unit approved Beginner Coaching Course within the previous 2 years (details of this will be forwarded to all interested parties).

Coaches must possess a thorough understanding of the rules of Polocrosse

The National Coaching Director on advice from the State Coaching Director must approve applicants for Level 1 accreditation.

Coaches must be a registered member with the Polocrosse Association of Australia Incorporated through their respective State Association

Coaches must be an Australian Citizen or an Australian permanent resident
