- b. Prayer Garden: a progress report was given by Mike S. We don't have an official bid yet but it was supposed to be around \$12,000. Memorial bricks will not be walked on. We plan to have 3 benches and Mary will be centered and facing the church. We talked about a light on Mary (either using electricity or solar). Nancy Hebl will engrave the bricks for us and they will be all standard size, font, etc. One person will be identified as the contact person in the church for the bricks. Since the "official" bid is not available, this project must be on hold currently. It was mentioned that Ann Draker's girls will take the orders. The Draker's are donating the statue of Mary. There is a sign-up at the back of church to order a brick. A brick example will be given to us by Nancy.
